Subject: Complaint Regarding Theft of Cement Load

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to bring to your attention a serious incident of theft that has taken place involving one of the drivers employed by my trucking company. I would like to request your immediate assistance in taking the necessary action against the individual responsible for this crime.

The driver name is Bikas Tamang, who has been working with our company for the past two years. It has come to our attention dated 27.01.23 that Driver Bikash Tamang has been involved in the theft of a significant quantity of cement. Upon further investigation, we have discovered that he sold all the Cement for personal gain.

The stolen load consists of 180 bags of cement, which were loaded onto the vehicle on Saturday date 25.11.2023. I regret to inform you that, unfortunately, the driver responsible for transporting the cement load has sold all the materials while en route and subsequently parked the empty vehicle in my godown. This incident has caused significant financial loss and disruption to the construction project.

As a responsible business owner, I am deeply concerned about this incident and the potential impact it may have on our reputation. Furthermore, I believe it is essential to ensure that appropriate action should be taken against Bikash Tamang to prevent any further criminal activity and to maintain the integrity of our organization.
