Respected Sir,

I, SRI BIJAI GHOSE, son of Late Keshab Chandra Ghosh, residing at Harisaya Police Station
Post Office —Siliguri Bazar, Police Station — Siliguri, Pin — 734 005, District — Darjeeling,, would like to inform you that I alongwith my 2 (two) brothers, (1) SRI SURYA GHOSH @ SURJYA KANTA GHOSH and (2) SRI BOJOY GHOSH @ BRAJEN GHOSH are the joint owners of altogether land measuring about 9 (nine) kathas in L. R. Plot No. 5, recorded in L. R. Khatian No. 402, 403 & 404, within Mouza — Thiknikata, J. L. No.74, Touzi No. 8, Pargana — Patharghata, Police Station — Matigara, District — Darjeeling and the total land is under one boundary with Iron Gate and 2 (two) shop rooms on the front side of the land which we are in possession.

Since SRI DHANANJOY ROY and SRI SAMIR KUMAR BASU tried to inter into our said land we have filed a suit vide Title Declaration Suit No. 290/2023 before the Ld. Civil Judge, Senior Division, Siliguri on 28/11/2023 and on the same date the Ld. Court was pleased to pass an order of interim injunction thereby making a direction for maintaining status quo of the nature and character of the suit property i.e. the said land. It is to be mentioned here that the said ad-interim order of injunction is in operation till 04/01/2024. Soon thereafter, on 29/11/2023, I had gone to your office and had served a copy of the said ad-interim injunction order.

Sir, on 08/12/2023, I had gone to Dhupguri for some urgent work and while I was there I got information from the care taker namely Sri Kamal Barman of the said suit property that one person named Dhananjoy Roy & his associates came to the said suit property located at Shushrutnagar (near Medical college) and forcefully took the key from the care taker and locked the shop room of the said suit property. At this police came to the spot. After this, when the police left the said spot, Dhananjoy Roy & his associates in a very intimidating and threatening way asked my men to leave the spot otherwise he will face dire consequences.

In this regard, it is to be mentioned here that the order of injunction passed by the Ld. Court has in clear and concise words has directed "to maintain status quo in respect of nature and character of the suit property", and since we are the owners and in possession of the suit property, maintaining of the status quo would imply that the possession of the suit property by us and our men would continue uninterrupted till 04/01/2024. Nowhere in the ad-interim order of injunction has it been mentioned that we should be deprived from enjoying the possession of the suit property, but the above named persons by violating the order of injunction and are trying to inter into the suit property.

Your good office is therefore requested to look into the matter and do the needful and also take appropriate action so that I and my men can enjoy the possession of the suit property uninterrupted in accordance to the order of the Ld. Court and also save us and our property from such illegal encroachment.
