
I Debojit Das, S/o Dipak Das, residence of Lokenath Sarani, Nabagram, P.O. Bhakti Nagar & P.S. NJP, Bhaktinagar, Siiguri, Dist: Jalpaiguri, Pin: 734007, in the state of West Bengal would like to state as followed:

- 1) That as on dated: 27.12.2023 around 7:30 P.M my brother along with one of his business colleague Miss Lilly Barman resident of Bagdogra was travelling on the Honda Activa 110 CC, Colour: Grey, Vehicle No.: WB 74 BC 9107 towards Naxalbari for some business purpose.
  - 2) That on the way when they reached Singhijhora T.E. near Bagdogra which come under your jurisdiction a motor cycle including the rider and pillion in a drunk state Vehicle No.: WB 74 BF 0080, Make: TVS APACHE RTR 160CC, Colour: Red came from the wrong way and collided with the Scooty directly after the serious accident one of the person in the Motor Cycle ran away from the spot and other person was lying there. The person who ran away from the spot with such inhuman nature and mentality without helping my brother or the lady or the person with whom he was in the bike ran way and showed his true nature and disgraced the basic human principles.
  - 3) That in the serious accident my brother named (Late. Dipankar Das) demised on the spot and the lady along with him had serious life injuries and is in a state that she might not make it and was rushed to North Bengal Medical College and Hospital where she was admitted in emergency care unit.
  - 4) That we are at a constant state of shock and fear after the demise of my brother Lt. Dipankar Das in the tragic accident and request that the person liable for the accident should be punished as per law.
- Therefore, kindly look into this matter and do the needful for the same and take strict legal action against them.
