Sir

I, the undersigned, wife of Bablu Basak daughter of Biren Roy resident of Fuleswari South Bharat Nagar, ward no:- 23, Siliguri (M. corp.), Rabindra Sarani, Siliguri Darjeeling, West Bengal, Pin no:- 734006 lodging this complaint against my lawfully wedded husband and in-laws to the effect that:

1. That I was married to one Bablu Basak, on 12/12/2009 and since then, I was residing at my matrimonial house i.e. Fuleshwari, Unnayan Colony, Siliguri, Darjeeling, 734001 with my father-in-law (Namely: Narayn Basak), Mother-in-law (Namely: Parwati Basak) and sister-in-law (Namely :- Mampi Singh).

2. That from my said wedlock one male child was conceived by me namely Pritam Basak, date of birth 28/12/2013 and another female child namely Tanisha Basak, date of birth 12/12/2019.

3. That since my marriage my husband who happens to be an alcoholic and possibly a drug addict was inflicting tremendous mental and physical cruelty on me with absolute abetment of my in-laws.

4. That since the birth of my first child my sister-in-law, Mampi Singh, was with a view that the said infant child was a curse for their family and for that reason my in-laws continued inflicting injury to my infant child (then namely Pritam Basak). With advent of time said grudge gradually increased and I was in fear that my in-laws might kill my infant child.

It is pertinent to mention hearing that during the same time period 2013/2014 my husband was arrested and in prison with regard to some drug related case and eventually I was driven out of my matrimonial home by my in-laws who at that time repeatedly inflicted injury on me and my infant child and thereafter I took shelter to my parental house.

5. That after quite some time when I got to know that my husband was out of prison I went back to my matrimonial house with a hope of a healthy married life with my husband and in-laws but they refuse to tuck me back. I being an unemployed mother having no way to secure the meets and needs

of my then infant child repeatedly to give me some shelter in my matrimonial house.

6. That since then it was a matter of the daily routine that my husband would come home late in an utmost intoxicated state and would beat me and my infant child mercilessly. This routine continued for quite some time and for the sake of the future of my infant child I resisted myself from lodging any complaint
7. That in the month of December 2019 my daughter was born namely Tanisha Basak and right after that the cycle of torture increased immensely by my in-laws.

It is pertinent to mention herein that my husband at that time was again arrested and imprisoned in another NDPS case.

8. That at the time, right after the birth of my daughter I was subjected to hear that the said daughter was not from my husband my in-laws treated my daughter as some kind of curse and I apprehended that she might be killed.
9. That for the safe custody of my children I moved back to my parental house, belonging from a below poverty level family, neither me nor my parents had the means to provide the shelter or healthy life style to my children, for that I repeatedly requested my in-laws to give me shelter to my matrimonial house.
10. That in the month of January 2022, I somehow resumed my stay at my matrimonial house to provide a roof over the heads of my children. It is very painful to mention that since then again the torture continued.
11. That in the month of December 2023, I came to know that my husband was out of jail and he has married to some other woman and they are residing at some other place. When I confronted my mother-in-law regarding the same fact, I was surprised that my in-laws knew about this second marriage of my husband.

On 26th December 2023, the said Mampi Singh (sister-in-law) became very violent at my infant daughter and tried to strangulate her with the rope with an intention to kill her. My mother-in-law also present there I somehow saved my infant child and ran away for the sake of my children's life and again came back to my parental house.

12. That on 28th of December 2023 I somehow managed the phone number of the lady with whom my husband committed the second marriage and called her, there I got to know that my husband has been cohabiting with his second wife namely Aarti Barman resident of Birpara Jalpaiguri.
13. That at the evening of 28/12/2023 my husband, said Bablu Basak came at my parental house and started shouting that he will kill me and my

children. When I opened the door of my house I saw that the said Bablu Basak was charging towards to me with a sharp cutting weapon I somehow closed my door and with the intervention of some good minded local people said Bablu Basak fled away from the place.

Under these above mentioned facts and circumstances I am compelled to lodge this written complaint to your esteemed authority to book these accused persons under the law of the land and ensure the safety of me and my family.
