I Sri. RAJA GUPTA, Son of Late Kartaram Gupta, resident of "Sri Sri Vatika" Apartment, Isckon Mandir Road, within the jurisdiction of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, Ward No. 41. P.O. Sevoke Road. P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, 734001, West Bengal, would like to bring to your kind notice that I am a CNF agent of Mansha Thai Food Private Limited. Mechi Nagar - 14. Duhagadhi, Jhapa, Nepal, a body incorporated. I am the authorized holder of the Trade Mark "AKBARE", which is registered in India by way of Trade Mark No. 5223192, Dated 25-11-2021, J. No. 2077 in Class 30. The items are Wai-Wai, 2PM, Rum-Pum and Current. It has come to our knowledge that within the jurisdiction of your Police Station my Trade mark is being misused. Such, fabricated and substandard quality of noodles and other products in the name of "AKBARE", which is being sold and marketed bringing not only huge disrepute to the branded name "AKBARE", but also being a negligent act plying with the health, nutrition and life of innocent buyers, such product being sold is not connected with Mansha Thai Food Private Limited and brings to fore huge health and severe concern to life for its users/consumers.

You are requested to look into this very serious matter impacting the health and life of innocent purchaser and end consumers at a very large scale within the jurisdiction of your Police Station. It has come to my knowledge that such counterfeit products may not be fit for consumption and may lead to hazardous disease, which further leads to loss of life at any moment.

I therefore, request to and expect from your office to take cognizance of this and initiate necessary action in accordance with the law.
