This is to bring to your notice that I, Agamani Das Bhagat, daughter of Ganesh Das, residing at Notun Para, Gossianpur, Bagdogra, P.O. and P.S.- Bagdogra, PIN- 734014 in the state of West Bengal, got married to Dinesh Bhagat (Mobile No. 9339000860), son of Shankar Bhagat, resident of Michael Madhusudan Dutta Lane, Near Chhathpukur, Ambikanagar, New Jalpaiguri, on 06.02.2007 at my father's house according to the Hindu customary rites and ceremonies and on such date my father Ganesh Das gave a bed, a dressing table, almirah, several utensils and cash amounting to Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) to my husband, Dinesh Bhagat, and also gave me several gold and silver ornaments for keeping a happy and prolonged conjugal life. But, after four years of our marriage, my husband Dinesh Bhagat was diagnosed with ailments in his reproductive organ, and he became impotent. Due to the impotency of my husband, I could not conceive. Thereafter, my husband was undergoing treatment and asked me not to desert him and gave me assurances that he would never abandon me even if we could not give birth to a baby.

It is to mention here that soon after this, there would be minor altercations amongst us almost on a regular basis until it reached a point that my husband started to abuse me mentally and physically. Thereafter, my father-in-law: Shankar Bhagat, my mother-in-law: Lakmanti Bhagat, my sister-in-law: Sunita Bhagat, brother-in-law: Ajay Bhagat and the wife of brother-in-law: Ankita Bhagat, together with my husband started to torture and abuse me mentally and physically and use invective language towards me and my family. Thereafter, my husband along with my in-laws started demanding money from me and my family for his treatment and on refusing to meet their demands, they confiscated all the streedhan that was received by me during my marriage and put it to use in a manner best known to them. It is pertinent to mention here that they not only used to ill-treat me but also taunt me and held me responsible for my husband's infertility. It reached to such a level that one day all my tolerance broke, and I decided to register a complaint against my husband regarding the rude and cruel behaviors of in-laws, but my husband confined me in a room for several days, barely gave me anything to eat and did not allow me to leave my matrimonial house at any cost. He would always keep me under vigilance and followed me everywhere I went.

It is pertinent to mention here that during 2021, my husband cured from his reproductive ailments and thereafter during the same year I was diagnosed with Thyroid and Appendix due to which I am unable to conceive. Thereafter, I started working as a nursemaid in order to put up with the expenses of my treatment as my husband was unable to cope up with the expenses of the treatment all alone. My husband thereafter moved me to a rented house, and we started living there together
