Subject- Requesting you to look into the matter of sexual harassment.

Respected Sir,

I, Pedenla Sherpa, am a resident of Darjeeling. I am a 26 year old woman currently preparing for the Civil Services. I am pleading you to help me in the absence of proper legal guidance and the "lack of evidence." I had a flight from Kolkata to Bagdogra on the 31st of January, 2024. I was travelling with 3 other people whose seats were right in front of me. The flight number - SG592, CCU to IXB. My seat was 10D, theirs were, 9D, 9E, 9F. There was this guy in 9C, the rest of the seats were vacant. He later moved to 9B. One of my family members wanted me to sit alongside them so I moved from 10D to 9C. I asked the guy if there was anyone sitting on 9C and he said no and so I shifted there. As soon as the flight took off I started feeling some poking on my left hand. I was wearing a thick puffer jacket and I still felt it. It was that guy's hands. He had both his hands on his right armrest. I thought since domestic flights are not very comfortable, it's okay. Mistakes happen. And then came the flight attendants to distribute food. That was when he became very alert and removed his hands. He started fidgeting alot. When I looked at him he was trying to hide his penis. He was using his phone and then his hands to cover it. That was when I realized that whatever he did to me was on purpose. As soon as the flight attendants went away he continued poking my hand. I still couldn't speak out as I was frozen. I was still processing everything that was happening to me. When I moved a little he brought his hands near my thighs and tried to grab it. I removed my seatbelt and he started apologizing right away. This happened even before I called the crew members.

After the crew members arrived, I told them what was happening to me. He acted like I was overreacting and it seemed like the crew members were listening to his side more than mine. Under pressure I slapped him once. Later he changed his seat. Upon arrival, the air hostess told me that they wouldn't be able to take any action against him and it would be difficult for me as well because I lacked evidence. When we met some officials in the Bagdogra airport, they told that since the accused is just a law student, it's better to let him go and not destroy his career. They also told me that police complaints would be very draining for me, mentally and financially. And since I even lack evidence, it would be his word against mine. One of them said that they would make him touch my feet and say sorry and that would be enough embarrassment for him. As one of my family members was on a wheelchair and we had to hurry home to get him admitted to the hospital, I listened to them. But that is not enough for me. I never wanted him to touch my feet or anything. I wanted him to get punished for what he did so that he doesn't dare to do it to anyone else.

I was in a hurry and not in the right state of mind so I resorted to whatever they said. However, now I want to take an action against him. He tried his best to prove that I was overreacting so I wouldn't want to stop until he accepts what he did. Sir I plead you to help me in the process. I am not very well versed with the law and it's process. But with whatever privilege I have, I want to use it against the molester so that this isn't repeated with anyone who isn't as privileged as I am. I've already taken it to the social media.

Sir I also request you to keep my identity anonymous.
