Sir,

With due respect I the undersigned, the Co-owner of a Tea Outlet cum Café namely "Khaabo Na Amra Chaa?" situated at Haren Mukherjee Road, Near Bhutia Market opposite Mahatma Gandhi Statue, would like to draw your attention to the matter briefed below:

1. That on 11.02.2024 at around 07.44 PM there were 04 staffs namely Joy Roy son of Late Malay Roy resident of Baladanga, District- Coochbehar (Cont. No.6297474255), Sital Mandal, Son of Lal Bachan Mandal, resident of Rana Nagar, Uttar Mathabari, District- Darjeeling (Cont. No. 7029610703), Sujan Das Son of Niranjan Das, resident of Bhutkura Coochbehar (Cont. No. 6296852448), Apu Das son of Abinash Das resident of Bhutkura, District- Coochbehar (Cont. No. 9382087387) working as servers and cooks in our outlet.

2. That at the said time two persons in an utmost intoxicated state came to our shop hurling abusive languages and started disturbing the other customers. On our several requests tendered to them to not to abuse and to approach the servers and other customers with parliamentary languages, they became more violent and started man-handling our servers.

It is pertinent to mention herein that at that point of time there were some female customers present who were being served, the unknown miscreants targeted their filth filled mouth towards them thereafter I, the undersigned Mr. Sumeet Kankani son of Shyam Sundar Kankani tried to prevent and impart some sense into them, however those efforts went into vein and instead of stopping one of the miscreant went outside and called two more persons equally drunk as them.

3. That in the said course one of the miscreants picked up a Tea-Pan containing hot boiling tea with an intent and attempt to throw the same to one of our servers namely Sital Mandal, however being prevented from doing the same the miscreant being ganged up with the other 03 miscreants grabbed the collar of Mr. Joy Roy who was standing beside said Sital Mandal, and dragged him into the deep fryer knowing very well that the fryer was there containing extremely hot boiling oil with an intent to cause grievous hurt to the said Joy Roy.

Being further pertinent to mention herein that even after dragging Mr. Joy Roy into the fryer containing hot boiling oil the miscreants did not stop there and started attacking the persons who came to rescue the said Mr. Joy Roy, amongst them there were 2 female customers who were trying to prevent the miscreants from entering into the shop and to rescue the other servers who were injured in the said course, the miscreants attacked them with an intent to outrage their modesty.

4. That with the help of some good minded local people the females and the other servers were rescued from the grasp of those miscreants and seeing a vile of crowd the miscreants fled away from the scene.
Very pertinent to mention herein that the whole incident is recorded in the CCTV footage of the outlet and ready to be produced for the perusal of your esteemed authority.

5. That after the miscreants fled away from the scene Mr. Joy Roy was taken to the Siliguri District Hospital for treatment, having his life at risk. In the course of the treatment it was found that Mr. Joy Roy had suffered 25% burn injury in his chest, left leg, right palm and also incurred severe cuts in his abdomen. Photographs of the same and the treatment details are annexed herewith.

Further pertinent to mention herein that the injury suffered by Mr. Joy Roy is such of a kind that he is still in the hospital and cannot be discharged in any time soon and in no way he will be able to follow his ordinary pursuits.

6. That the other servers (above named) who happen to be the eye witnesses of the said incident were also the victims of the wrath of those drunken miscreants and had suffered injuries which also had to be treated in Siliguri District Hospital.

It is very regrettable to mention herein that the place of occurrence happens to be in the heart of our town and ordinarily known to be a place prevalent with peace and tranquillity, and an incident like this poses a question towards the safety of the common people.

Under above mentioned facts and circumstances it is hereby requested to your esteemed authority to take action in accordance with the law and book the miscreants for the larger public interest.
