Sir,

In producing herewith one (01) accused person named Bappi Mahato (25yrs) S/O Lt Ram Krishna Mahato of khola chand Fapri near Durga Mandhir PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

- i) One iron made improvised Fire Arms having its trigger, hammer and firing pin measuring approx 09 Inches including its butt, body and barrel [The articles have been found kept concealed on back side of waist of accused Bappi Mahato which is marked as 'Exhibit-A']
- ii) One (01) live ammunition which was kept inside his Right pocket and marked as 'Exhibit-B'

I, SI Youel Iepcha S/O Jai Tshering Iepcha of Bhaktinagar PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate would like to lodge this written complaint against the above noted arrested accused person to the effect that today on 25.02.2024 at about 00.15 hrs received an information that one person had been waiting at kholachand Fapri near Forest range office under PS- Bhaktinagar for committing heinous crime and he used to carry and possess small arms & ammunition with him. Accordingly I requested him to come and identified the accused. Wasting no time, I diarized the information in Bhaktinagar PS General Diary Book vide GDE NO- 1317, Dated 25.02.2024 and consequently informed the tip off to you for kind instruction. Subsequently, on being directed, I along with ASI- Chandra Prakash Adhikary , ASI Dipak Karmakar, C/674 Debraj Biswas, and C/ 912 Nakul ch Singha left Bhaktinagar PS for perusing the information by Govt. Vehicle. Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender.

After reaching there I called the following two persons namely i) Mahadev Sarkar (35yrs) S/O Lt Shankar Sarkar of Kholachand Fapri Po Salugara PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri, ii) Bidhan Bapari (27yrs) S/O Sushil Bapari of Kholachand Fapri Po Salugara PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and make them aware of the information in hand and requested them to act as witness, if any search and seizure would be made necessary upon which they agreed. Subsequently, after contacting my secret source and being informed and identified I along with my accompanied officer and force conducted raid in presence of witnesses I apprehended the above noted accused person named Bappi Mahato as identified by source. Searched him immediately and recovered the above noted articles from his conscious and exclusive possession kept concealed at his back side of his waist under cover of his wearing apparel.

Subsequently, being interrogated, the apprehended person disclosed his identity as noted above. Further being interrogated he admitted that he has collected the said Fire Arms and ammunitions from Bihar. On demand he failed to produce any document in support of his possessing and carrying of such type of fire arms and ammunitions. Hence, it is evident that the accused named Bappi Mahato exclusively & consciously possessed this improvised fire arms with live ammunitions illegally with some ill motives.

Thus, when his involvement in carrying and possessing illegal fire arm established, I seized and labeled the above noted articles at the spot under proper seizure list duly signed by him as well as by the above noted independent witnesses and also put my signature on the seizure list and label. Therefore I arrested him under proper memo of arrest and informed him the ground of his arrest.

From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles there is strong reason to believe that the accused Bappi Mahato (25yrs) S/O Lt Ram Krishna Mahato of khola chand Fapri near Durga Mandhir PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri has carried the said fire arms with live ammunitions with an objective to commit heinous crime in the locality.

So, I pray before you for starting a case against Bappi Mahato (25yrs) S/O Lt Ram Krishna Mahato of khola chand Fapri near Durga Mandhir PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law as he has willfully violated the regulation of Arms Act and for arranging its investigation.
