1. 15 (fifteen) different size of Flag of ABVP, Uttar Banga fitted with bamboo stick.

I SI Paresh Barman of New Jalpaiguri PS beg to report that today 11/03/2024 at 07-55 hrs myself along with other officers and force were performed law & order duty at Tinbatti More under New Jalpaiguri PS in c/w the "Uttarkanya Abhiyan" as called by the "Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad, vide NJP PS GDE No.506, dated-11/03/2024. Today at around 14-30 hrs as per their scheduled approx 700 supporters of "Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad" proceeded towards Uttarkanya the Secretariat of the Chief Minister, West Bengal having sticks with their traditional flags with shouting slogans against the State Govt. after assembled somewhere at Jalpaimore unlawfully without any prior permission from the concern authority as well as police authority. Accordingly we cordoned the said rally at Kathaltola more to obstructed their movement towards Uttarkanya, but they became violent. So said assembly was declared as unlawful assembly by the on duty Executive Magistrate. Thereafter the members of the said unlawful assembly were stopped near Tinbatti More under NJP PS by us following superiors order to maintain Law and order at the area as well as for prevailing peace and requested them to obey the Law and immediately vacate the place.
