**SUBJECT: Reporting of burnt of 33000 VOLTS live cables by miscreants at location chainage 1/5-6 of Rangapani to BPMS Military siding Near Medica Cancer Hospital.**

Dear sir,

It is for your kind information that undersigned is looking after Railway Electrification works of Rangapani to BPMS Military siding with 25000 V AC single phase . As per Railway Board's guideline all overhead electrical power lines upto 33000 volts should be converted to underground before charging of 25000 Volts AC .

So at Chainage of 1/5-6 Near Medica Cancer Hospital provided by Railway 33000 Volts 630 sqmm ,single core,Aluminum XLPE HT cables for conversion of NBU to PS-1 & TCF 33000 Volts overhead feeder into underground. This 33000 KV line is under Divisional Manager, WBSEDCL & conversion work carried out with proper supervision of WBSEDCL & also this feeder maintain and use by WBSEDCL. On dated 07.03.2024 the FEEDER line charged with cables after completion of all safety parameters.

Today at 8.20 AM it is brought to my knowledge by Assistant Engineer, WBSEDCL, Shivmandir that mentioned 33000 Volts feeder tripped in their control room & after survey by Linemen/WBSEDCL it noticed that all 5 cables were burnt by the external fire .After that I rushed to site & found this is done by miscreants by external fire. This is High voltage feeder and this type of activities may cause severe casualties of human & animals ,Power cut in major portion of area & loss to Government properties.

Hence you are requested to take necessary action so that such activities may not happen in future.
