Sir,

I, Khusboo Singh, wife of Dr. Dinesh Kumar, Daughter of Amar Singh, resident of Loknath Sarani, Nabagram, P.O.- Bhaktinagar, Police Station: N.J.P., District Jalpaiguri, do hereby lodging this F.I.R., which is as follows:-

A. That on 05-06-2023 I, got married to one Dr. Dinesh Kumar, Son of Sudama Prasad Gupta, resident of Ashok Nagar, P.O. & P.S. Bagdogra, District: Darjeeling, according to Hindu Rites and customs at Hotel Grand Palace Banquet, Tinbatti More, P.O.- Bhaktinagar, Police Station – N.J.P., District - Jalpaiguri, and at the time of my marriage my in-laws demanded for Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) in cash and my parents had fulfilled the said demand and one reception party was organised on 07-06-2023 at the resident of my in-laws. It is added further that, soon after our reception party, on 10-06-2023 I along with my husband left for Delhi, as my husband is a scientist by profession and working at Viral Research & Diagnostic Laboratory, Department of Microbiology, Lady Hardinge Medical College & Associate Hospitals, in Delhi.

That as my husband is a Scientist by profession; he used to be very busy this day to day work and for that reason, since after our marriage, my husband always maintained distance with me. It is not out of place to mention here that since after our marriage, we do not have any conjugal

relationship and my husband used to avoid me since after our marriage, even at our rented house in Delhi we used to stay at different rooms.


C. That during the stay in Delhi, one day I got physically intimated with my husband and at that time I came to know that my husband is not physically fit and when my husband comprehended that I got to know the fact of incapability of my husband, my husband started avoiding me, being an Indian woman, I also wanted to give him some time, so that he can get accustomed with the situation. And on 20-09-2023 we came to our matrimonial house and on 21-09-2023, we celebrated the birthday of my husband too. Thereafter, on 25-09-2023, my husband went back to Delhi with a promise that he will come back on chhatt puja and at that he will take me along with him to Delhi, but as soon as my husband left me at my matrimonial house since that day my in-laws started inflicting torture upon me and when I informed the matter to my husband, he did not care a straw. During the stay at my matrimonial house I used to do all the household works and at that time I intimated my sister-in-law named Nayantara Gupta, wife of Ashok Gupta, resident of Bagdogra, District – Darjeeling about the physical incapability of my husband because we had a cordial relationship but unfortunately the said Nayantara Gupta started mental torture upon me. It is not out of place to mention here that my another sister-in-law, Priyanka Kumari and her husband Ashok Kumar, both being the resident of Ashoknagar, Bagdogra, District – Darjeeling, started to mentally torture and abuse me by saying ; - “ **Tui ekta baaje meye.**” “ **Amar bhaiyer jibon theke beriye jaa!**”. The three said persons namely Nayantara Gupta, Priyanka Kumari and her husband Ashok Kumar admitted that they were aware of their brother’s physical incapability and that they suppressed the fact before our marriage commenced.

D. They drove me out of my matrimonial house on 21-11-2023 and that time I contacted my parents and my mother came and took me. After that I along with my family members tried to patch up the matter but all were in vain. It is pertinent to mention here that, my husband was well informed about the incident but he did not raise any objection. It is further added that on 30-12-2023, my husband came to Siliguri but did not make any contact with me, being aware that my father invited my husband to my parental house on 03-01-2024 and on that day my husband and his relatives had inappropriate behaviour towards me and also my in-laws along with my husband demanded dowry from my father, as my father raised objection, they left our house without any further communication and on 05/01/2024, my husband abandoned me and went back to Delhi, since then I don't have any contact with my husband and since then I am residing at my parental house. It is pertinent to mention here that 24/02/2024 my father called my husband but all were in vain, subsequently on several occasion we tried to patch up them matter but they did not come but always threatened me with dire consequences.

Being helpless lady, I am praying before you to take appropriate legal action against the said miscreant so that I can get proper justice from the administration.
