I, Smt. Babita Jaiswal, Wife of Ajay Kumar Jaiswal, R/o. Jyotinagar Colony, Near Hans Primary School, Ward No. 04 of S.M.C. under the P.O. Siliguri Bazar, P.S. Siliguri, PIN- 734005, Dist: Darjeeling in the state of West Bengal would like to inform you as follows:

1. That I am legally wedded wife of Sri. Ajay Kumar Jaiswal S/o Juit Bandhan Jaiswal. Our marriage was solemnized on 18th February, 2013 at Sahu Bhavan located at Burdwan Road, Siliguri by following Hindu rights and customs in presence of the family members of both the families. After marriage I started cohabiting with my husband in my matrimonial home.
2. That at the time of our marriage my father gave me various gold ornaments, and other valuables such as utensils and furniture and etc. as a Stree Dhan as per their demand.
That soon after two days of my marriage, when I was busy arranging all of my valuable ornaments to store it in my almira all of a sudden my husband and in laws came and forcefully pressurized me to handover all the gold and silver jewellery to them by stating illogical reasons as it will be sin if all of the thing remains in the custody of newly wedded wife. In such a situation I was compelled to hand over the same to my in-laws.
- That after the above noted incident I was treated well in my matrimonial house for 7-10 days. Soon after the said period one day when I was about to enter the Pooja Ghar in my matrimonial home but out of nowhere suddenly my mother in-law forcefully restricted me to enter the said Pooja Ghar by stating that I am impure and does not fit into their culture.
5. That gradually directly and indirectly they had started rising physically and mentally torturing upon me by demanding dowry from my parents as this dowry demand was not fulfilled by my father at the time of our marriage. Upon refusal to the same as my father was under a lot of debt after my marriage, my in-laws including my husband imposed a cruel environment upon me.
6. That out of the lawful wedlock I gave birth to a female child namely Aradhya Jaiswal on 20/04/2015 at the Siliguri District Hospital and giving birth to a female child that had become a curse for them that they always wanted a male child. Soon after I was taken back to the matrimonial home my in-laws did not even came to my room to see my child.
7. That as it was my first child and I was unable to handle my child properly, one day upon requesting my mother in-law to hold my child in her lap as she was crying badly, she took and threw my child on the bed by stating that my child does not belong to their blood.
8. That in 2016 finding no other alternative I had lodged written complaints before the appropriate police authority being G.R. No. 2760/2016 and before the appropriate court of jurisdiction being Misc Case No. 172/2016. Subsequently, for that time being the matter and torture was under control as they were under fear. During that time I was treated well in my matrimonial home. Their several strategies in the shade of requests have convinced me to withdraw the cases filed by me and subsequently, in 2018 the cases were withdrawn accordingly.

9. That after the cases were withdrawn again 1 month later they started shredding their faces and again their inhuman tortures started increasing day by day. Being so helpless and looking at my child I was bearing with all the issues that I was facing. Their one and only demand was that they always needed the dowry amount that they claimed at the time of the marriage.
10. That I was not given proper food and means to maintain me and my child which resulted in strong starvation during that time period.
11. That on 2023 my father being unable to see all of the tortures have manage sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five Lakhs) only by taking loan from any money lender in interest @10% P.A. and the same amount was handed over to my husband in the presence of my in-laws.
12. That after the said payment my husband and in-laws renovated their home properly and created some additional living space. Subsequently after some time out of no reason they started abusing my minor child both physically and verbally. From the time of her birth, till date they do not like my daughter because she is a female child. They restricted her entry in their room even most of the times they lock her outside the house by not opening the locked gate. I protested all of these several times and that resulted in various verbal and physical tortures upon me and my child.
13. That subsequently on 09/03/2024 by crossing all their limits all of a sudden my brother in-law broke into my room in intoxicated state and by inappropriately touching and holding me threw me out of the room and later on my other in-laws including my father in law came and held my hairs from my back and this was the other in-laws physically assaulted me with fists and blows by graciously injuring me. Later that day I along with my minor daughter rushed to the Siliguri District Hospital where the treatment of me and my child was conducted.
14. That on the same day I visited the Women P.S. Siliguri, from there I was referred to the Khalpara T.O.P. but the authority had refused to take up my matter leaving behind me in such a helpless condition they suggested me to settle it out with my in-laws. They did not even paid any heed to it as I was in such a life threatening condition.
15. That till date after the incident I am residing with my father at Ganga Nagar, ward No. 05, Siliguri. Considering the suggestion of the officer of Khalpara T.O.P. and the future of my minor child I again tried to settle it out with the help of the concerned Ward Councillor but nothing fruitful happen. As a result of that presently I am compelled to file this written complaint.

In the light of the statement as stated above I therefore requesting the concerned authority to take necessary legal actions so that proper justice can be served to me.
