Sir,

In producing herewith two accused persons namely Kuldeep Pradhan (40 yrs), s/o- Late Nabin Pradhan, resident of Daragaon, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and Bikash Munda (38 yrs), s/o- Late Madan Munda, resident of Kiran Chandra T.E, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling under custody along with twelve (12) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60° UP India Made Liquor, each contains 375 ml @ Rs. 100/- (total 4.50 ltrs & total value Rs. 1200/-) under proper seizure list.

I, SI Samik Paul of Bagdogra PS, SPC, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above mentioned arrested accused persons namely Kuldeep Pradhan & Bikash Munda to the effect that on 11.04.2024 at 12:05 hrs I received secret source information that a huge quantity of liquor is stored at the shop cum house of one Kuldeep Pradhan situated at Daragaon under PS- Bagdogra and the same has been selling illegally. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and as per direction, I along with ASI Amit Lama, VP/02 Prodi Roy & CV/389 Janak Singh left for Daragaon to work out the secret source information. This refers to Bagdogra PS GDE No. 444 dated 11.04.24. At around 12:25 hrs we reached at Daragaon and being indicated by source we held raid at the shop cum house of suspect Kuldeep Pradhan at Daragaon to verify the veracity of information. Seeing the police personnel they tried to flee away from the spot. But we managed to apprehend two persons and interrogated them. On interrogation, they revealed their identity as Kuldeep Pradhan (40 yrs), s/o- Late Nabin Pradhan, resident of Daragaon, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and Bikash Munda (38 yrs), s/o- Late Madan Munda, resident of Kiran Chandra T.E, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling. Kuldeep Pradhan introduced himself as the owner of said shop. We disclosed our identity and the input we had to them. We contacted with the local people to be present as witness during the process of search, seizure, if any but none of the local people agreed to be present as witness. Then, we conducted search at the said shop in presence of Police witnesses. On search, the above noted liquor was recovered from the said shop of Kuldeep Pradhan. On demand, they failed to produce any valid document/license for stocking and selling that liquor. On prolong interrogation, they confessed that Bikash Munda had come there and sold that liquor to Kuldeep Pradhan. They further confessed that they have been stocking and selling liquor illegally from the said shop for a long time for their wrongful gain. Accordingly, I seized that liquor under proper seizure list & label and at last, arrested the accused Kuldeep Pradhan & Bikash Munda (as noted above) after observing all legal formalities and telling them the ground of arrest and issued memo of arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest was made in between 12:45 hrs and 13:45 hrs on 11.04.2024.

Therefore, I request that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the accused persons namely Kuldeep Pradhan (40 yrs), s/o- Late Nabin Pradhan, resident of Daragaon, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and Bikash Munda (38 yrs), s/o- Late Madan Munda, resident of Kiran Chandra T.E, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and arrange for its investigation.
