Sir,

I, SI Binup Mahato of NJP PS, Silliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Bablu Gain (46) S/o Lt. Panchanan Gain of Paschim Dhantala, Sattelite Township PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. 12 (Twelve) Nos sealed Bottles of Himalayan gold country spirit 60 up, each bottle 600 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-A1.
2. 18 (Eighteen) Nos sealed Bottles of Himalayan FATA FATI India made liquor 70 up, each bottle 300 ml, Marked as Exhibit-B from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-B1

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 14.04.24 at 18-15 hrs received source information that one person was selling Liquor illegally to his designated customers at near Battalion More under New Jalpaiguri PS, Dist.- Jalpaiguri without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and O.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself alongwith ASI Dhruvo Mishra, ASI Khagen Barman, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, CV-84 Niru Yadav all of NJP PS, SPC left for Battalion More to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS GDE No. 771 Dated- 14.04.24. On arrival at the spot at 18-45 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from near Battalion More to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seen the police party some customers as well as the seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I recovered the above noted articles from his possession and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C. as It's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made in between 19-25 hrs to 20-15 (seizure Total approx 12.6 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against one arrested person namely Bablu Gain (46) S/o Lt. Panchanan Gain of Paschim Dhantala, Sattelite Township PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
