In producing herewith four (04) arrested accused persons namely (i) Sushanta Saha @ Dullu (27) S/O Asutosh Saha of Majhabari, PO-Goghomali, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, (ii) Bikram Das @ Vyadhol Das (23) S/O Sapan Das of Majhabari PO- Goghomali, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, (iii) Subham Sikdar @ Naton (21) S/O Manik Sikdar of Hayderpara Saratchandra Pally, PO- Hayderpara, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and (iv) Rakesh Das @ Arindum Das (29) S/O Ramen Das of Ramkrishna Sarani, Niranjannagar, ward no.-36, PO- Goghomali, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with the following articles seized viz:

- I. One iron made Sharp cutting steel made knife measuring approx. 8 inches (approx.) in length seized from the possession of Sushanta Saha @ Dullu which was kept concealed on his back side.
- II. One iron made sword measuring 29 inch (approx.) including wooden butt seized from the possession of Bikram Das @ Vyadhol Das which was kept concealed on his back side.
- III. One iron made 'Khukri' measuring 17 inch (approx.) seized from the possession of Subham Sikdar @ Naton which he was carrying on his left hand.
- IV. One iron made weapon locally called as "Bhojali" measuring 18 inches (approx.) seized from the possession of Rakesh Das @ Arindum Das.

1. ASI Prasenjit Barman S/O Lt. Sarat Chandra Barman of Ashighar Out Post under Bhaktinagar Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this complaint against the above noted 04 (four) arrested accused persons namely (i) Sushanta Saha @ Dullu (27) S/O Asutosh Saha of Majhabari, PO-Goghomali, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, (ii) Bikram Das @ Vyadhol Das (23) S/O Sapan Das of Majhabari PO- Goghomali, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, (iii) Subham Sikdar @ Naton (21) S/O Manik Sikdar of Hayderpara Saratchandra Pally, PO- Hayderpara, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and (iv) Rakesh Das @ Arindum Das (29) S/O Ramen Das of Ramkrishna Sarani, Niranjannagar, ward no.-36, PO-Goghomali, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and another 07/08 unknown involved accused persons to the effect that today on 16/04/2024 at 00:05 hrs, I received a source information that 11/12 youths have assembled near Fakdaibari Bazaar with deadly weapons and making preparation for committing dacoity in a house at Fakdaibari Bazaar area. Accordingly, I informed the matter to the O/C, Ashighar OP and diarized the fact in General diary vide Ashighar OP GDE No.500 dated 16/04/2024. After getting the permission from the OC Ashighar Out Post, I along with ASI Amit Mallick, C/376 Shyamal Chaudhury, C/9743 Koushal Roy and C/134 Ginen Basumata all of Ashighar Out Post left for Fakdaibari Bazaar to verify the veracity of the information. Under these circumstances any search warrant or authorization for search cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender. At about 00:20 hrs we reached near Fakdaibari Bazaar and met with my source and as pointed by the source we noticed that 11/12 persons were assembled in a dark place at Fakdaibari Bazaar and were whispering in a very low voice. Then we cordoned the place very carefully with a strong reason to belief that they were preparing to commit some cognizable offence and started walking towards them. But seeing police personnel approaching towards them they tried to flee away. However on hot chase we managed to apprehend above noted four (04) accused persons with deadly weapons in their possession but 07/08 persons managed to flee away from the spot taking the advantage of darkness and open place. On being asked the detained persons disclosed their identity as noted above. On interrogation they give different statement in different time and failed to give any satisfactory reply for their presence in the middle of night with deadly weapons.

Finally, they disclosed that they along with their associates had assembled there and were making preparation for committing dacoity in a house at Fakdaibari Bazaar area. Accordingly, I seized the above-mentioned weapons of offence from their possession under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and acknowledged by the accused persons and subsequently arrested them under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest, I accordingly brought all the four arrested accused persons along with seized article at Ashighar Out Post for further investigation. During interrogation it could be revealed from the arrested accused persons, that they had gathered there and were making preparation for committing dacoity in a house at Fakdaibari Bazaar area. The whole process of seizure was made in between 00:40 hrs to 01:10 hrs.
