Sir,

In producing herewith following seized article under proper seizure list i.e. twelve (12) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60° UP India Made Liquor, each containing 600 ml @ Rs. 155/- (total 7.20 ltrs & total value Rs. 1860/-).

I, ASI Amit Lama of Bagdogra PS, SPC, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the absconding accused person namely Malti Majhi (F/34 yrs), w/o- Tulko Majhi, resident of Bhujipani, Rail Busty, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 18/04/2024 at 18:05 hrs I received secret source information that a huge quantity of liquor is stored at the house cum shop of Malti Majhi situated at Bhujipani, Rail Busty under PS- Bagdogra and the same has been selling illegally. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and diarized the matter in GD vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 109 dated 03.04.2024. Accordingly, as per direction of O/C Bagdogra PS, I along with ASI Munna Ahmed, CV/386 Kishor Ranjan Howladar & CV/375 Jogesh Barman left for Bhujipani, Rail Busty vides GDE No. 741 dated 18.04.24. At around 18:25 hrs we reached at Bhujipani, Rail Busty and planned for holding raid. At around 18:35 hrs being shown & indicated by source we held raid at the house cum shop of suspect Malti Majhi to verify the veracity of information. We saw some customers taking liquor from the said house cum shop and one person was selling liquor to them. Seeing the police personnel the customers and the seller managed to flee away from the spot. On enquiry, it could be learnt that Malti Majhi (F/34 yrs), w/o- Tulko Majhi, resident of Bhujipani, Rail Busty, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling is the owner of said house cum shop. We contacted with the local people to be present as witness during the process of search, seizure, if any but none of the local people agreed to be present as witness. Then, we conducted search at the said house cum shop in presence of Police witnesses. On search, the above noted liquor was recovered from the said house cum shop of Malti Majhi. On demand, none came forward to produce any valid document/license for stocking and selling that liquor. On further enquiry it could be learnt that said Malti Majhi has been stocking and selling liquor illegally from his said house cum shop for a long time for her wrongful gain. Accordingly, I seized that liquor under proper seizure list & label in presence of Police witnesses. The process of search, seizure & label was made in between 18:35 hrs and 19:25 hrs on 18.04.2024.

Therefore, I request that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the absconding accused person namely Malti Majhi (F/34 yrs), w/o- Tulko Majhi, resident of Bhujipani, Rail Busty, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and arrange for its investigation.
