Sir,

I SI Nirmal Kr. Das, O.C. New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC like to lodge a complaint as suo-moto to the effect that SI Sunil Gurung, sector officer of Police Sector No. 8 had got an information that today 19.04.24 at about 10-30 hrs Smt. Shikha Chatterjee alongwith 20/30 persons violating prevelling 144 Cr.P.C. order had entered within the restricted 100 mtrs area of Booth premises of Chaturagachh Junior High School where booth No. 19/86, 19/87, & 19/88 are situated. On getting that information SI Sunil Gurung alongwith his accompanied police forces and taking civil sector Officer Shri Madhyam Moktan, Asstt. Professor Rajganj college, Civil Sector No. 25 and his team had been at Chaturagachh Junior High School and found Smt. Shikha Chatterjee and her team consist of 20/30 persons, both male and female, were present there within about 40 mtrs of Booth premises of Chaturagachh Junior High School. Civil Sector officer asked Smt. Shikha Chatterjee to produce her authorization to visit the booth premises during poll. Smt. Shikha Chatterjee failed to produce any authorization and stated that she is the sitting MLA of this Assembly Constitution and she can roam any where under her constituency, but the civil sector officer informed her that she can only be present within 200 mtrs of any Booth premises if only she had a proper authorization from ECI and she never can moved around with 20/30 supporters with her which is clear violation of prevelling 144 Cr.P.C order. Smt Shikha Chatterjee and her compinions left the place uttering some unparliamentary and displeasing words addressing to Civil Sector Officer and Police personnel. But Smt Shikha Chatterjee did not leave NJP PS area and roaming at different places, visiting different booth camps. We kept a sharp vigil over her activities.

Thereafter, at 13-15 hrs I came to learn that the said Shikha Chatterjee alongwith 40/50 people were gathered nearby St. Josef High School and Nabogram Primary School at Laketown under NJP PS. There are Booth No. 19/252, 19/253, 19/254, 19/255 at Nabogram Primary School and Booth No. 19/250, 19/251, 19/256, 19/257 are at St. Josef high School. Immediately I directed RT-1 team headed by SI Ganesh Roy and Sector Officer ASI Binay Subba of Police Sector No.XI alongwith their accompanied forces to attend the information and also informed MCC team headed by Shri Hemanta Mani of Rajganj BDO Office. Also deputed LSI Mimi Singha and LC-1328 Sangeeta Maley to accompany RT-1 team. The police and MCC team had been at the spot and found Smt. Shikha chatterjee alongwith 40/50 supporters both male & female are sitting by the side of the road approx 180/190 mtrs away from Nobagram Pry. School and St. Josef High School, in such a manner and with such an attitude that their mere presence is sufficient to cause fear in the mind of the voters who are not their supporters. Moreover Smt. Shikha Chatterjee herself engaged in asking the passerby various questions thereby, unduly influencing the election process. She also canvassing to vote for BJP to the common people.

Seeing Smt shikha chatterjee there with her companions and their act of vote canvassing and undue influence at Election Shri Hemanta Mani asked her to immediately leave the place and stop that activity. Smt. Shikha Chatterjee hearing this became infuriated and asked her companions, present there, to forcibly disbursed the MCC team and police team from there and shouted at the top of her voice that she is MLA of that area and she can do anything, she is willing to do and her supporters whatever the number is will be present with her. The supporters of Smt. Shikha Chatterjee got charged with her such provocative abatement and started to scuffling with the police party and MCC team, as a result some of the police personnel namely (1) SI Ganesh Roy (2) C/1654 Biplab Das (3) C/1683 Partha Das Singha (4) NVF-0065 Prakash Roy (5) ASI Binay Subba (6) C/1502 Ranjit Ghosh (7) HG-675 Swapan Barman (8) LSI Mimi Singha (9) LC-1328 Sangeeta Maley got some injuries and lady police personnel also manhandled by male supporters, resulting outraged of their female modesty. In this way shikha chatterjee left the place boarding a small vehicle having registration No. WB-74-BP-1911.
