Sub : Complaint against illegal construction and threatening by Naresh Chandra Barman and his associates in wilful violation and disobedience of the order of injunction passed by the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court in C.O. No. 8 of 2021 on 19.03.2021

With due respect, I the undersigned Sri Rajesh Gupta, Son of Late Jatan Prasad, resident of JP House, Nehru Road, PO. & PS. Siliguri, District : Darjeeling [West Bengal], being the caretaker of the landed properties of my nephew Sri Rakesh Kumar Gupta, Son of Sri Rup Chand Prasad, Resident of JP House, Nehru Road, PO. & PS. Siliguri, [West Bengal] and also as his constituted attorney, like to state that my said nephew purchased the land measuring 0.11 Acres, appertaining to RS Plot No. 1 as recorded in RS Khatian No. 2/20 of Mouza Thiknikata, PS. Matigara, District : Darjeeling [West Bengal] since a long back periods and that the said plots of land along with the land of one Sri Amit Kumar Gupta was surrounded by brick built up wall in all sides fitted with gate.

It is stated that due to act and conduct of one Sri Naresh Chandra Barman, Son of Sri Karuna Mohan Barman, resident of Indira Pally, Kadamtalla, PS. Matigara, District : Darjeeling [West Bengal] along with his associates, I had/have been compelled to lodge one complaint to Matigara PS vide GDE No. 148 of dated: 03.08.2018 and that I have also been compelled to commence one proceedings under Section 144 of Cr. P. C., against the said persons vide Petition Case No.136 of 2018 and also to institute one Title Suit being No. 194 of 2018 to the Court of the Ld. Civil Judge [Jr. Division], Siliguri. It is stated that against the order passed by the Learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Siliguri in the said suit, my said nephew represented through me preferred his appeal before the Learned District Judge, Darjeeling which was subsequently transferred to Court of the Learned Additional District Judge, Third Court at Darjeeling and that the said appeal also heard and disposed of by the said Learned Court vide order dated: 18.06.2020. And against the said order passed by the said Learned Court, the above named Sri Naresh Chandra Barman preferred his Revisional Application before the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, vide C.O. No. 1150 of 2020, subsequently re-numbered as C.O. No. 8 of 2021 and that the said Revisional Application was heard and disposed off by the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, Circuit Bench at
