That me and my brother namely Bipplab Biswas are unemployed and were searching for a job for our livelihood, meanwhile Alok Mondal informed us about one foreign job vacancy which was opened in Canada and he stated that I have to do data entry in a repudiated company situated in Canada and salary the is about Rs. 50,000/- (INR) per month/ 600 US Dollar approx individually.
 4. That being a lower middle class family Rs. 50,000/- per month is more than enough for us so that we agreed to do the job offered by Alok Mondal and he brief us about the job and interview and Alok Mondal instructed us to appear before interview and finally we cracked the online interview.
 5. That after cracking our interview Alok Mondal said us to make Passport as soon as possible and we rush to make our Passport and somehow we managed to make our Passport within a month.
- That after making our Passport Alok Mondal explain us regarding the expenses to get the job in Canada and Alok Mondal asked us to pay sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakhs Fifty Thousand) for each (total amounting to Rs. 3,00,000/-) cash for flight tickets
