Sir,

I, SI Binup Mahato of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Malati Roy, age 39 years, Female W/o Lt. Jatin Roy of South Colony bazaar, Sribas Colony PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. 17 (Seventeen) Nos sealed Bottles of Himalayan gold country spirit 60 up, each bottle 600 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-A1.

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 12.06.24 at 14-20 hrs received source information that one lady was selling Liquor illegally from her house at South Colony Bazar, Sribas Colony under New Jalpaiguri PS, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to its customers without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and O.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself along with SI Tanmay Kundu, ASI Khagen Barman, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, LC- 746 atoshi Roy, CV/824 Niru Yadav CV/306 Biswajit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for South Colony Bazar, Sribas Colony to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS GDE No. 643 Dated- 12.06.24. On arrival at the spot at 14-45 hrs it was found that one female person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from her house to his designated customers to earn huge money for her livelihood. On seeing the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by lady police, on being asked she disclosed her name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses namely 1. Jaychan Majumder (38) S/o Lt. Birendra Nath Majumder of South Colony Bazar, Sribas Colony PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and 2. Satyen Das (55) S/o Naresh Das of Michel Madhusudan Colony PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri I recovered the above noted articles from her house and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said apprehended female person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed her guilt. As such I arrested the above noted female accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C with the help of lady police with maintaining strictly her female modesty, as it's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made in between 15-05 hrs to 15-45 hrs (seizure Total approx 10.2 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against the above noted arrested lady person namely Malati Roy, age 39 years, Female W/o Lt. Jatin Roy of South Colony bazaar, Sribas Colony PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
