To Whom It May Concern,

I, Shree Prosenjit Bala, son of Prabash Bala and resident of Dayaram Jote, P.S + P.O - Naxalbari, Dist - Darjeeling, WB - 734429, am writing to report a tragic incident involving my elder brother, Pramath Bala, aged approximately 28 years.

On 01-07-2024 at around 1:00 PM (noon), my brother was traveling on his bike, a **Royal Enfield Classic Chrome 350** with registration number **WB74BD5185 (Chassis No ME3U3S5F2LL979376, Engine No. U3S5F1LL612622)**, heading towards Bagdogra from Ghoshukur on NH-27. Unfortunately, near Bhujiya Pani, he collided with a white **INOVA** car bearing registration number **WB73E1999**.

The collision resulted in critical injuries to my brother, and despite our immediate efforts to rush him to North Bengal Medical College, the doctors there pronounced him dead upon arrival.

I kindly request you to register an F.I.R. regarding this incident and initiate the necessary investigation.
