Sir,

I, SI Tanmay Kundu of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Raj Biswas (20) S/o Gokul Biswas of Pachkelguri, PO Sahudangi PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. Eight (08) Nos sealed Bottles of Himalayan FATAFATI country spirit, each bottle 300 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-A1.
2. Eight (08) Nos of sealed Bottles of Himalayan Gold Country spirit 60 up, each bottle 600 ml, Marked as Exhibit-B from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-B1

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 04.07.24 at 19-15 hrs received source information that one person was selling Liquor illegally from in front of his shop at NJP station near NJP Truck Stand under New Jalpaiguri PS, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to its customers without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and O.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself along with ASI Nilam Swarnakar, C/1462 Sajan Tamang CV/824 Niru Yadav CV/306 Biswajit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for NJP Station near Truck stand to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS GDE No. 233 Dated- 04.07.24. On arrival at the spot at 19-45 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from in front of his shop NJP Station near NJP Truck Stand to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seeing the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses namely 1. Ujjal Paul S/o Lt. Radesh Paul of Janatapara W.No. 35 PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and 2. Sankar Bhawal S/o Lt. Sadananda Bhawal of NJP Bhaktinagar, W.No. 35 PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri I recovered the above noted articles from his possession and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said apprehended person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C, as it's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made in between 20-45 hrs to 21-05 hrs (seizure Total approx 07.2 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against the above noted arrested person namely Raj Biswas (20) S/o Gokul Biswas of Pachkelguri, PO Sahudangi PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
