Respected Sir,

With due respect, I SMT. SHILPA SARKAR DAS, Wife of Sri. Soumen Das, resident of Ambika Nagar, Fulbari G.P. 1, Dabgram, P.O. Sahudangi Hat, P.S. New Jalpaiguri, District Jalpaiguri, W.B.-734015 beg to state that I am absolute owner of a land measuring about 1(one) Katha 13(thirteen) Chhataks 7(seven) Sq.ft., recorded in Khatian No. 127, under L.R. Plot No. 284, situated within Mouza Thiknikata, Pargana Patharghata, P.S. Matigara, Dist. Darjeeling within specific boundaries by virtue of a registered Deed of Sale being no. I-5375 for the year of 2023 and I have all documents of ownership in respect of such property including chain deeds, L.R. Khatian etc.

Sir, on 27/05/2024 and also on 05/06/2024, Smt. Gita Sarkar and Sri. Biki Sarkar have forcibly tried to capture my land for their illegal gain by breaking the lock of the main gate.

Finding no other alternative, I filed a civil suit along with injunction application against said Smt. Gita Sarkar and Sri. Biki Sarkar in the Court of Ld. Civil Judge Junior Division at Siliguri being Title Suit No. 102/2024 and said application for temporary injunction was moved on 14.06.2024 and after hearing Ld. Court was pleased to allow the prayer for ad-interim injunction in my favour and thereby restrained the above named Smt. Gita Sarkar and Sri. Biki Sarkar from entering into my above mentioned land and from disturbing my peaceful possession till 16.07.2024.

In spite of order of the Ld. Court, the above named Smt. Gita Sarkar and Sri. Biki Sarkar along with one land Broker Sri. Nilotpal Sarkar(Bappa) have been continuously disturbing me and they are disregarding the order of Court, and have forcibly tried to capture the land for their illegal gain by breaking the lock of the main gate. They have prepared some forged and fabricated documents to capture my land for their illegal gain.

Therefore, I request you to take necessary legal action against said (1) SMT. GITA SARKAR, (2) SRI. BIKI SARKAR, both are resident of Milan Pally, Near Ram Thakur Mandir, Ward No. 25, P.O. Siliguri Bazar, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, West Bengal, (3) Sri. Nilotpal Sarkar (Bappa), Son of Late Dilip Sarkar, resident of Kawakhali, P.O. Sushrutanagar, P.S. Matigara, Dist. Darjeeling and also to see that the order of Ld. Court may not be violated by them.
