Sub: Criminal complaint relating to mental cruelty, sexual abuse, financial exploitation, abuse and illegal detention of my personal effects, jewellery and stridhan, under Sections 498(A) and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 against My husband, Sri Vivekananda Sarkar, Son of Bhidhuranjan Sarkar, Resident of Near Bengal Sweets, Ambika Nagar Bazar, Near Rail Hospital, P.O. and P.S. Siliguri, District: Darjeeling, West Bengal - 734004 (Whatsapp - 9933409690 8906081098)

1. I, Smt. Maman Mahanta Sarkar, Wife of Sri Vivekananda Sarkar, Residing at Putimari Fuleshwari, Near Uday Sangha Club, Chandamari, P.O. Putimari Fuleshwari, P.S. Kotwali, Dist. Coochbehar, West Bengal -736157 presently at Meghlal Roy Road, Sarat Chandra Pally, Ward No. 40, P.O. Haiderpara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District: Jalpaiguri, West Bengal - 734006 am the legally wedded wife of the Sri Vikendananda Sarkar.
2. I am currently unemployed and completely dependent on my parents and relatives for expenses. I am constrained to file the present complaint as I am tired of mental, physical and financial cruelty and exploitation that has been meted out to me by my Husband on me and my minor daughter.
3. I had a love marriage solemnized on 23 November 2005 at a temple in Siliguri according to Hindu rites, ceremonies and customs and thereafter petitioner started residing with the him in a rented accommodation in Siliguri.
4. At the time of marriage, the husband and his family members had told me and my family members that my husband used to work at a company named Cals India in the Siliguri branch and used to earn about Rs. 6,000 per month. I and my husband had met each other at this workplace as I was also working there at that time.
5. Within three/four months of the marriage, we shifted to the matrimonial home of situated at Putimari Fuleshwari, Near Uday Sangha Club, Chandamari, P.O. Putimari Fuleshwari,

- P.S. Kotwali, Dist. Coochbehar, West Bengal - 736157 and from the said wedlock we have daughter namely Jhilik Sarkar presently aged about 14 years.
6. My mother-in-law was abusive towards me and would hurl abuses. My mother-in-law would always threaten me that she would commit suicide if I would not engage in household chores. My husband's family would rear cows and goats in the matrimonial home and I was asked to clean their dungs on a regular basis even though I time and again explained my inability to engage in such tasks. I was always willing to do other household work.
 7. I believe that since we had a love marriage, my husband's mother would not like me. Moreover, I have also been taunted by the husband's family for being dusky of complexion and for being overweight. That apart, my husband's family would also complain that I did not bring any dowry at the time of the marriage.
 8. When I had come to the matrimonial home I was told by my mother-in-law "*Siliguri te chele esechilo kaj korte, tumi unarke fasiye deyocho*" (My son had come to Siliguri for work, you have entangled him in all this).
 9. As my husband would travel on account of work and it was difficult for me to manage our child alone along with so much household work, therefore we shifted to my maternal home at Meghlal Roy Road, Sarat Chandra Pally, Ward No. 40, P.O. Haiderpara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District: Jalpaiguri, West Bengal - 734006 with my parents.
 10. After the marriage when my family went to the matrimonial house in Coochbehar after about 2.5 years of the wedding, my parents were forced to provide Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) in cash towards dowry.
 11. We were married to each other for almost two decades. However, about three years ago (around November 2022) I learnt that my husband is having an affair with another woman at his workplace by the name Rupa Banerjee. I have seen that he was on a bike with Rupa Banerjee in our area. When I questioned him about the woman, he evaded it by saying that they work together and he had merely come to drop her as she lives in the area nearby.
 12. On other occasions, I have observed that he had been speaking to her at odd hours in the night on the messages under the pretext of work. When I questioned him about this he would respond "*Chele meye kaj kar-te pare*" (Man and women can work together).
 13. I have also seen a message on his phone "*Tomar baba k je kotha diyechi sheta jonno aami rakhte pari*" (I will take care of you as I have promised your father to do so) and "*Ami more jabo kintu tomake chara thakte parbo na*" (I will die but I cannot live without

you). When I questioned him he yet again evaded the topic by saying there is nothing between the lady and him. When I still insisted, he deceived me by saying that Rupa Banerjee and him are playing a game and that I would not understand it. It is a ploy by him to extract money out of Rupa Banerjee.

14. Thereafter he also started crying before me since I was not believing him. I told him that I will reveal to all the family members that he is engaging in such conversations with another woman. He continued to lie to me by saying that he was doing all this to extract money out of Rupa Banerjee and when he would be successful he would stop it. I told him that I am not interested in receiving any money through such false means and he should stop engaging in the extra marital affair.
15. On other occasions, he and Rupa Banerjee would talk on the phone in Nepali with each other as I don't know Nepali. Whenever my husband and I would go to Coochbehar to my husband's family, Rupa Banerjee would comment on him "Ki korche bal tumi keno jacho bar bar Coochbehare" (Why the hell do you keep going to Coochbehar again and again).
16. Rupa Banerjee would also send lists of her groceries to him. That apart she would ask for Bluetooth earphones, basket for clothes for about (Rs. 2,500/-), recharge of her phone from him and EMI of Rs. 16,500/- for probably a property they are purchasing together.
17. My husband has been staying out of the house the whole day under the pretext of work and he would leave early morning, pick up Rupa Banerjee and they would stay together the whole day. I have intimate photos of them together and whenever I would question my husband he would say you would not understand, we were out on account of work.
18. My husband has been extremely controlling throughout the married life inasmuch he has restrained me from engaging in any gainful employment or mingling with other people under the pretext of love and care towards me.
19. He continuously manipulated me to believe there was no relationship between Rupa Banerjee and him even though he was addressed as the husband of Rupa.
20. In January 2024, when I yet again confronted him about his illicit relationship, he left the matrimonial house after accepting about his affair only to return in two weeks.
21. Now he has left the house again and washed his hands from all the responsibilities towards me and my child who is at a tender age of 14 years and totally dependent on me for her daily support and education. Even I have not been provided with any support or care from him and I am solely dependent on my parents for my daily survival.

22. That over all these years I have been facing immense pain and agony in my married life despite which I have endeavored to bring peace and harmony in my marital life for the sake of our child also but all my efforts went in vain. Now my husband has deserted me and is refusing to fulfill his responsibilities as the husband.

23. I have been subjected to mental torture and till date has been facing mental trauma and tremendous financial crisis in providing for myself and my child.

24. My husband has my jewelry that was given to me at the time of marriage and he has refused to return it to me. He asked for it by telling he wanted to purchase a property through it and after that he has neither given me any share in the property nor returned my jewelry.

25. Therefore, I request you to register a complaint against my husband on the above grounds.

This complaint has been drafted by my advocate upon my instructions and the same has been read over and explained to me in my vernacular and I affirm the contents of the same.
