I Saurav Ghosh, S/O Late Sanjib Kumar Ghosh, one of the Directors for and on behalf of Aastha Hospital (A Unit of Aastha Health Care Private LTD.) do hereby wish to inform you that one patient namely Majral Haque resident of Ramganj, Betbari, Masidkhas, Uttar Dinajpur-733207, was admitted on 26.06.2024 for the treatment of CKD on HD and discharged on 30.06.2024. Subsequently he along with his well wishers/family members again visited our hospital on 02.07.2024, 05.07.2024 & on 09.07.2024 for Hemodialysis.

On 09.07.2024, the patient party also enquired about the expense of Permacath Procedure. On that day, they in fact contacted with our temporary staff named Sujit Karak resident of Mohitnagar, Baksipara, Jalpaiguri- 735102 (Mobile No.: 8167067970).

On 11.07.2024 it is found from the record that our said staff Sujit Karak left our hospital premises at around 04:16 pm. Suddenly, at about 07:30 pm, the above said patient party visited along with their deceased patient at the reception of our hospital, by a vehicle WB73G0933 (Tata Magic). Then and there the patient party demanded for the patient's death certificate from our hospital but as the patient was neither admitted or treated after Hemodialysis on 09.07.2024 nor expired at our hospital, we clearly refused to give them any death certificate. After listening this the patient party got violent and started shouting and also gave filthy languages to our doctors and staffs. They also damaged our hospital property by breaking glass of our Pharmacy and tried to damage more. They threatened our doctors and staffs stating that they are lawyers and will take down the hospital.

It is very surprising to find out that since 11/07/2024 (after 04:16 pm), Sujit Karak has not visited our hospital and very cleverly fled away since then. We tried to contact him but we have failed.


