Sir,

In producing herewith one seized Tractor, make of model "SONALIKA DI-47 RX "bearing No. WB-91 TC-02 loaded with river bed materials i.e Sand.

I PSI Amit Saiba of Bagdogra Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 22.07.2024 at about 14.05 hrs received a secret source of information that one tractor loaded with river bed materials is coming from Hansqua side towards Singhijhora on AH-02 under Bagdogra PS to illegally disposed the same. Accordingly I informed the matter to on duty GDE officer and as well as the O/C Bagdogra PS and as per his kind direction I along with ASI Sheshnath Jha, C/283 Dani Barman left for Singhijhora under Bagdogra PS to verify the veracity of the information vide Bagdogra PS GDE no-938 Dated-22.07.24. On arrival at the spot at about 14.20 hrs as indicated by source I noticed that one tractor loaded with sand materials going towards Singhijhora side but seeing the police team the driver of the offending tractor speeded his vehicle. We signaled the drivers of the said tractor to stop but he did not had any response to police personnel. Any how we intercepted the above noted tractor. In the mean time driver of the said tractor fled away towards tea garden area leaving the tractor on the road. I then searched and found that the tractor was loaded with river bed materials i. e sand but did not found any documents in favour of the said tractor as well as river bed material i.e sand. There is strong reason to believe that the said tractor loaded with river bed materials was stolen by the drivers by fraudulent meant to clandestinely dispose the same. Finding no other alternative, I seized the said "SONALIKA DI-47 RX "bearing No. WB-91 TC-02 loaded with river bed materials i. e Sand under proper seizure list in presence of witnesses maintaining all formalities of seizure and weighed the same which is approx 80 CFT. As per provision the entire process of search and seizure was made by audio/video electronic means which is attached herewith. The search & seizure was made in between 14.25 hrs to 14.35 hrs.

Therefore I pray before you to start a specific case against the driver and the owner of the seized "SONALIKA DI-47 RX "bearing No. WB-91 TC-02 under proper section of Law and arrange for its investigation.
