Sub: **Urgent Complaint about Threatening, Vandalism, and Attempted Assault**

Sir,

I, **Sri Chot Mal Joshi**, aged 86, resident of **Joshi Kunj, Sevoke Road, Siliguri, Dist.- Darjeeling, W.B.**, am writing to bring to your immediate attention a series of criminal activities that have taken place on my property. My late wife, **Smt. Parmeshwari Devi Joshi**, purchased the land measuring 11 Katha corresponding to **R.S. Plot No. - 537 & 542 at Mauza Rupsingh, J.L. No. -95**, District - Darjeeling, by virtue of registered deed no. 1867, dated 08-03-1988 at the office of Sub-Registrar, Siliguri, from Mrs. Purnima Ghai, W/O Surinder Ghai.

On **29th September 2023**, through a registered deed of Lease vide I-7866, I legally handed over this land to the lessee, **Sri Subrata Roy**, S/O: Late Nirod Roy, Proprietor of M/S City Marble, Gossainpur, resident of Rupsingh Jote, Dakshin Bagdogra, P.O & P.S: Bagdogra, Dist: Darjeeling, for his marble business.

Recently, a group of individuals, namely (1) **Taposh Deb**, S/O: Late Pradip Deb, (2) **Manash Deb**, S/O: Late Pradip Deb, (3) **Subham Deb**, S/O: Malay Deb, (4) **Subir Deb**, S/O: Malay Deb, (5) **Shirshendu Deb**, S/O: Tapash Deb, and (6) **Kaushik Deb**, S/O: Biplab Kr. Deb, have been aggressively harassing and threatening the lessee, **Sri Subrata Roy**. They have been unlawfully claiming ownership of the land and attempting to intimidate my staff and labourers.

Over the past two nights, these criminals have escalated their actions by using abusive language, hurling lit torches (MASAL), and throwing stones into the premises with the intent to cause destruction and fear. Last night, they broke the entrance gate lock, causing a loud noise and creating a state of panic and trauma among my staff and labourers. Additionally, they tore the branding flex of the business, further vandalising the property.

I am an elderly man suffering from physical ailments, and I am not in a position to confront these threats. These actions have put my life in grave danger, and I demand immediate intervention from the authorities to protect my property and ensure the safety of all individuals present on it. It is crucial to note that these individuals have no legal right, title, or interest in this land. They are former legal heirs of the sellers and have no legitimate claim. I have authorized the lessee, **Sri Subrata Roy**, to handle all matters related to this land on my behalf.

I insist that you take swift and decisive action against these perpetrators to prevent further harassment and potential violence.
