**Subject: First Information Report**

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Mrs. Neetu Agarwal, Wife of Mr. Pravin Agarwal, aged about 42 years, resident of Prakash Nagar, Salugara, Ward No. 43 of S.M.C., Post Office – Sevoke Road, Police Station - Bhaktinagar, District – Jalpaiguri, West Bengal - 734001, presently residing at Hundred Pearls, Jyoti Nahar, Word No. 41 of S.M.C., Near Bottle Company, Post Office – Sevoke Road, Police Station - Bhaktinagar, District – Jalpaiguri, West Bengal – 734001, would like to inform as follows:

1. That I am the wife of Mr. Pravin Agarwal, who has a furniture factory in the name and style of “Seeya Steel” at Prakash Nagar, Salugara, Ward No. 43 of S.M.C., Post Office – Sevoke Road, Police Station - Bhaktinagar, District – Jalpaiguri, West Bengal – 734001, near our previous residence.
2. That my husband on a regular basis keeps on visiting the said furniture factory for work purposes, and on many occasions carries considerable amount of cash with him for the purposes like labour payment, payment of expenses in the factory, raw material purchase and also the collection of the sale proceeds from the factory.
3. That on 28/07/2024, at around 09:50 p.m., while my husband accompanied by one of his staffs namely Mr. Rattee Lal, was going to his said furniture factory to inspect the days work, a car being No. WB 74 AX 3401, stopped near my husband’s car, and he was attacked by four unknown miscreants coming out of that car and was mercilessly beaten by them. Mr. Rattee Lal tried to resist the said four miscreants, but he was also beaten by them. These four people kept on beating my husband for a considerable long time almost beating him to death.
4. In the meantime Mr. Rattee Lal somehow managed to escape from that place and informed the local residents nearby about the sudden attack by those four miscreants, and some of those local residents rushed with Rattee Lal to the place where those four miscreants were beating my husband. On arrival the local residents found that these four people beating my husband till then, and they rushed to save him. Three of the four miscreants there ran away, and the fourth rushed towards the car in which these four miscreants arrived at the spot. The local residents stopped the fourth miscreants and

beaten him and broken the glass of the car in which those four miscreants were arrived. One of the local residents took the photograph of the number plate of the said car and provided the same to us.

5. That my husband was taken to the Nayak Nursing Home, at Sevoke Road, Siliguri, by few people present there and was admitted in emergency.

A copy of the Admission Slip is hereby enclosed as **Enclosure C1**.

6. That since my husband was taken to the hospital he was unconscious, and regained his senses in the morning of 29/07/2024, and told me that he was carrying an amount of Rs. 1,28,000/- which he collected from the sales at Shivmandir, which was snatched by the three miscreants who ran away that night, alongwith the gold chain which he was wearing around his neck.

7. That my husband is still admitted in the said hospital and is under treatment.

In the above facts and circumstances you are most respectfully requested to register the present complaint as an FIR and further do the needful to punish the said miscreants for almost beating my husband and his staff to death and forcefully snatched away the amount of Rs. 1,28,000/-, and the gold chain, alongwith the other allegations as made above in details.
