Subject: FIR.

Madam,

I, Manisha Rajak, wife of Bikey Gupta, currently residing at Nehru Road, Opposite ShyamRachna Apartment, Ward No. 7 of S.M.C. VidyaSagar Pally, Siliguri, 734001, hereby lodge this complaint against my husband, Bikey Gupta, and his family members for subjecting me to continuous mental and physical cruelty and for abducting my elder daughter, Reshu Gupta.

My marriage with Bikey Gupta took place on 19/01/2018 at Khalpara, Shivajee Road, Ward No. 8, Siliguri. Since our marriage, I have been subjected to mental and physical torture by my husband namely Bikey Gupta, my mother-in-law namely Fulmati Devi Prasad, father-in-law namely Motilal Prasad, and sister-in-law namely Rinku Prasad, Rina Gupta and Durga Shah, due to their dissatisfaction with the dowry provided by my family. They frequently used abusive language against my family members and assaulted me on several occasions, demanding more money from my family.

On 20/10/2019, I gave birth to our daughter, Reshu Gupta. After her birth, the mental torture escalated, particularly because they were disappointed that I gave birth to a girl instead of a boy. After 3 years it was found that our daughter was suffering from autism and for which their cruelty intensified. They blamed me for our child's condition, further increasing the mental and emotional abuse. After discovering that our daughter has autism, my husband and his family members expressed their desire to abandon her. On multiple occasions, they pressured me to give her up for adoption to someone else. On 13/04/2024, when I was 5 months pregnant, my husband, along with my sister-in-law, Rinku Prasad, assaulted me brutally. I lodged a written complaint at the Siliguri Women Police Station, and a case was registered (Case No. 36 of 2024). Following this incident, I returned to my parental home with my daughter.

promising no further harm. Believing his words and considering my advanced pregnancy, I returned with my daughter. On 05/08/2024, I gave birth to another baby girl at Siliguri District Hospital. My husband was present during the delivery. However, on the next day (06/08/2024), my husband and in-laws did not visit me at the hospital. Their phones were switched off, and I remained without food the entire day. Later, I learned from my family members that my husband, mother-in-law, father-in-law, and sister-in-law, Rinku Prasad, had taken my elder daughter, Reshu Gupta, and left our home under lock and key.

On 08/08/2024, my family members came to the hospital, discharged me, and took me to my matrimonial home. Upon arrival, I found that all my belongings had been thrown on the terrace, and my mobile phone was damaged due to rain. I assume that my husband and in-laws have taken my elder daughter to Gwalior as he is currently employed there as a teacher at Vibrant Academy and the full address of the place of coaching is Shri Ram Kripa Complex, City Center, Kailash Vihar Colony, Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, 474002, and I am left helpless with a 4-day-old baby in my lap. I fear that they might harm my elder daughter who is suffering from autism or may try to get rid of her as she is currently in their custody.

I humbly request you to take immediate and necessary action against my husband, Bikey Gupta, and his family members for domestic violence, mental and physical cruelty, and abduction. I also request you to ensure the safe return of my elder daughter, Reshu Gupta.
