Sir,

I, Rohit Kumar Pathak, S/O Manoj Pathak, resident of Tower No. 7 MIG Uttarayan Township, would like to lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2024 at around 2:00 AM I went to City Center, Matigara while I was going through lift from groundfloor to 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and along with my friends namely Anamika Lepcha, Arpana Pradhan, Jeet Ghosh and more 2 friends were there who were present with me in the lift. That few hooligans who were intoxicated with drugs and alcohol came and entered in to the lift and thereafter they started touching my female friends inappropriately when I went to object to such act of hooligans, they pushed me back.

That thereafter they started beating me and my friends in the lift and in furtherance to which I suffered Severe injury in my left eye and the multiple abrasions due to which my whole left eye got destroyed, Bleeding from nose, Left Sided face, cut injury in back, the left eye was raccoon in nature and my friend namely Jeet Ghosh his left legs ligament was torn. They also used iron knuckles and other sharp weapons with an intention to kill us. That it is pertinent to mention that even they committed the afore said act with my female friends, they also threatened us with dire consequence. That the hooligans even after several request to spare me and my friends but they deliberately kept on beating me and my friends from lift to entry gate of Uttarayan.
