Sir,

I, Sri Rajkumar Singh, S/o Jogin Singh, resident of Dengaa Par, P.O. Patkoi Hat, P.S. Kocha Dhaman, Dist. Kishanganj, Bihar, would hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect as follows:

That on 12.08.2024 an incident took place where my Son namely Niraj Kumar got injured in his hand while he was playing he unknowingly put his hand into the Sugar Cane crusher and in furtherance to such his left hand was severally injured. That thereafter I took my son to MGM Medical College Kishanganj from where they referred me to take my son into CARE N CURE Nursing Home, Matigara.

That whereas on 13.08.2024 I admitted my son namely Niraj Kumar, aged about 3years in CARE N CURE Nursing Home Matigara and on the same date Dr. Nitin Naik operated my son due to emergency situation. That thereafter the aforesaid Nursing Home demanded a Lump sum amount in furtherance to the operation conducted by Dr. Nitin Naik and I submitted before the Nursing Home administration that I am unable to pay such a Huge amount demanded but in such pretext I transferred an amount of Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand Only) (Rs. 15,000/- was transferred through bank account and the details are enclosed herewith and remaining amount of Rs. 20,000/- is paid in cash) on 23rd August, 2024.

That subsequently when I convey to the Nursing Home administration to release my Patient namely Niraj Kumar but the same was rejected by Dr. Nitin Naik and his manager Malkeet Singh and one staff namely Ashim Roy

and the Nursing Home authority told us that the patient required doctor's observation as the patient has not recovered fully after operation.

But now presently when I demanded my son to be released the same was denied by the Nursing Home administration and told us to pay more an amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Only) for the release of patient. The aforesaid Nursing home even stopped me and my family members to meet my son until I pay the remaining Lump Sum amount.

They even restrained my wife namely Rina Devi in the aforesaid Nursing Home premises and until I pay the demanded amount to Dr. Nitin Naik. The Malkeet Singh (Manager) slapped me and my wife toady when I went into the Nursing Home for reducing the claimed amount and gave me abusive languages.

That it is pertinent to mention here that my son was fine by 23rd of August, 2024 and there was no such requirement to hold my son in the Nursing Home. There is no further improvement of the patient after 23rd Of August, 2024.

That the Dr. Nitin Naik, Malkeet Singh and Ashim Roy desperately with the intention to deceive me by an increased bill and threatened me of dire consequences with death by their musclemen if I do not pay the aforesaid amount as demanded by them.

That if my son is not released from the aforesaid Nursing Home his hand shall be in a deteriorating Condition which requires the immediate medication.

It is therefore requested to acknowledge this written complaint and take the necessary action by framing charges against Mr. Nitin Naik, Malkeet Singh, Ashim Roy and his muscle men whoever are involved in this conspiracy as per to the law in force.
