I, SI Ganesh Roy of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Dipak Das (30 yrs) S/O Lt. Ranjan Das of Baribhasha Madani Bazar PS New Jalpaiguri Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. Twenty (20) sealed Bottles of Himalayan FATA FATI 70 up country spirit, each bottle 300 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A.

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today 12.09.24 at 23-05 hrs I received source information that one person was carrying and selling Liquor illegally at South Colony near Battala Bazar under NJP PS to its customers without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and O.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself alongwith C/152 Abdul Kayum Mia, VP-13 Jamirul Islam all of NJP PS, SPC left for South Colony to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS GDE No. 635 Dated- 12.09.24. On arrival at the spot on 12.09.24 at 23-55 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from South Colony near Bottala Bazar to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seen the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above and also confessed that he is selling Id Liquor illegally to his designated customers without any license. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I recovered Twenty (20) sealed Bottles of Himalayan FATA FATI 70 up country spirit, each bottle 300 ml from his possession and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked he failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 35 BNSS as It's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made on 13.09.24 in between 00-05 hrs to 00-35 (seizure Total approx 6 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against one arrested person namely Dipak Das (30 yrs) S/O Lt. Ranjan Das of Baribhasha Madani Bazar PS New Jalpaiguri Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
