Sir,

I Sri Bikash Jaiswal, Son of Sri Binod Jaiswal, resident of 28C/1, Uday Nagar, VIP Nagar, Kolkata- 700100, would hereby like to lodge this written complaint to the effect that I along with Sri Abhishek Dalmia and Sri Ankush Shaw (this are my partners of a Partnership firm namely M/S Andaaaz Hospitality) had entered into a Tenancy Agreement with Sri Ashok Kumar Agarwal on 05th October 2023. Whereas I required a Space for commercial purpose and in the aforesaid Agreement Sri Ashok Kumar Agarwal handed over me the possession of a shop space measuring 1100 sq.ft on the Upper ground floor/ first floor of B+4 storied building known as Life- Aid Building and the monthly rental amount was amount of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only). That in furtherance to such Agreement I had paid a security amount of Rs. 4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Fifty Thousand only).

That thereafter I started my business of Restaurant namely Sanklap with my partners namely Sri Abhishek Dalmia and Sri Ankush Shaw. That subsequently Mr. Ashok Kumar Agarwal suddenly started to demand an increase monthly rental amount of Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) and if the said increased amount is not paid by me as a result he told me to vacate the premises as because he had a tenant of High Amount/rental amount but I requested him to look the issue sympathetically and I was continuing the business.

That latter on when I with the consent of my partners decided to Renovate our Business/Restaurant and for such renovation my restaurant was closed for few days and that I and my partners were busy in arranging the capital/fund for such renovation and when I returned back to my tenanted

premises I was shocked to notice that in the meantime Mr. Ashok Kumar Agarwal and his hatch men with the mala fide intention had broken the main Shutter of My shop and forcefully they broke my Shop Key and forcefully entered into my shop premises and I was shocked to notice that the said hatch men were performing certain construction/alteration work and my renovation work was stopped by them and all the valuable articles which were in the restaurant was not present there. Hence, it is my immense belief that such valuable articles had been stolen by the said Ashok Kumar Agarwal and the valuable articles which includes movables and immovable of my Restaurant and the description of such valuable articles are as follows:

1. Music Speaker of Phillips,
2. CCTV camera installed,
3. kitchen utensils which includes Chimney, refrigerator of ICE MAKE Co. ltd,
4. 3 AC of Voltage Co.
5. valuable furniture such as Wooden chairs, fancy tea tables, Dining tables,
6. other valuable decors items.

That when I requested those hatch men not to alter my property but the same was denied by them and they started hitting me and assaulted me and threw me outside the premises with the caution that if I take any legal action against Ashok Kumar Agarwal and his hatch men they shall put my life to an end and with other dire consequences.


That it is my immense belief that Mr. Ashok kumar Agarwal had misappropriated such articles for his personal use and had also intentionally misappropriated the aforesaid security amount paid by me.

That some cash which was kept in Cash Drawer amounting Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) approx. and I believe that the said amount was also under the unlawful Custody of Ashok Kumar Agarwal and it is

pertinent to mention that I had suffered a loss of total Rs. 30,00,000/- to 40,00,000/-.

That I do hereby request you to acknowledge this written complaint and recover my valuable articles along with the cash amount and take the necessary action against Mr. Ashok Kumar Agarwal and his muscle men under the due process of law.
