In producing herewith one accused person namely Mohammad Abbas, aged 50 years, s/o- Late Mohammad Alauddin, resident of Masjid Para, Shanti Nagar, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) under custody along with following banned fire crackers under proper seizure list:

(i) Four packets of 'Jil Jil' firecrackers.

(ii) Thirteen packets of 'Jolly Cola' firecrackers.

(iii) One hundred packets of 'POP POP' firecrackers.

I, ASI Amit Lama of Bagdogra PS, S.P.C, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above mentioned arrested accused person to the effect that on 23.10.24 at 17:15 hrs I received secret source information that a huge quantity of banned fire crackers is stored at the grocery shop cum house of one suspect namely Mohammad Abbas at Masjid Para, Shanti Nagar and the same has been selling illegally from that shop. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and diarized the matter in GD vides Bagdogra PS GDE No. 1098 dated 23.10.2024. Then as per direction of O/C Bagdogra PS I along with SI Debabrata Kundu, ASI Munna Ahmed, C/1509 Sourav Roy Sarkar, LCV/99 Rohita Minj, VP/01 Ansalam Kujur, VP/02 Pradip Roy, CV/386 Kishor Ranjan Howladar & CV/389 Janak Singha left for Panighata Road, Upper Bagdogra to verify the veracity of secret source information. This refers to Bagdogra PS GDE No. 1099 dated 23.10.2024. At around 17:50 hrs we reached at Masjid Para, Shanti Nagar. On being shown and indication by the source, we held raid at the grocery shop cum house of the suspect. On search, the above mentioned banned firecrackers were recovered. I asked the owner of the shop cum house to produce any valid license for storing & selling U/S 218/227 banned fire crackers. But he could not produce any such document. I informed him that he has disobediently violated the orders of the Hon'ble supreme Court of India vide Judgment dated 23.10.2018 in W.P(C) No. 728 of 2015 and directives of Hon'ble National green Tribunal in O.A. No. 249/2020 dated 09.11.2020 and 01.12.2020 duly promulgated in all electronic and print media vide memo No. 321-3L/WPB-E(VI)/2020 dated 26/10/2021 of West Bengal Pollution Control Board that "... there shall be a complete ban on the sale and bursting of all kinds of fire crackers, except green crackers in the State of West Bengal, till further orders in this respect ..." On being asked the shop owner revealed his identity as noted above and confessed that he has been selling such type of banned fire crackers for his wrongful gain. He also stated that he was acquainted with the fact that the sale and purchase of all type of fire crackers are banned this year as per order of the Apex Court. There is a reasonable ground that the alleged accused has been negligently and illegally selling those banned fire crackers without any valid license or permission endangering the human life and has also violated the Govt. order.
