Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I, ASI Nayan Kr. Das of N.B.M.C. OP under Matigara P.S. do hereby lodge this complaint as Suo-motto to the effect that today on 25/10/2024 at about 15:20 hrs while I was engaged in performing Evening Mobile Patrolling duty along with force vide N.B.M.C. OP C.C. No. 1368, Dated 25/10/2024 within the North Bengal Medical College and Hospital, observed that some persons are loitering near Blood Bank of North Bengal Medical College and Hospital, without accompanying any patient or to meet any Doctor for their own treatment. As the activities of those persons were suspicious, I along with C/942 Raju Barman and VP/06 Nitish Singha started keeping watch on those persons. After a while I found that those persons are talking with some patients as well as some patient parties and took them to an isolated place. I followed them and saw that those persons were collecting money from the patient as well as patient parties. Seeing cash transactions by those persons with the patients and patient parties, I went forward to make queries regarding cause of such exchange of money. By seeing approaching Police, those persons started running and fled away from here. I made queries to the patient parties and learnt that those persons told the patients and patient parties that if the patient parties do not pay a huge amount of money to those persons, patients could not get any bed, blood or other facilities in the hospital and the patients will die without any treatment. Those persons took money from patient parties putting them into such fear, to facilitate in obtaining bed, blood etc. at the NBMC & Hospital to them. I requested the patient parties to lodge a complaint but they denied as they were worried and busy with their patient, even they denied to disclose their identity as they do not want to get involved into any legal litigation. Finding no other alternatives regarding complaint, I file this complaint as Suo-motto so that legal action can be taken against the persons involved who were collecting money for providing various health facilities at NBMC & Hospital.

I, therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be started against the involved persons who were engage in the above mentioned illegal activities and to arrange for its investigation.
