In producing herewith two accused persons namely Nikhil Roy (M/57), s/o- Late Bhusan Ch. Roy, resident of Khudiram Pally, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling & Rohit Thakur (M/20), s/o- Somnath Thakur, resident of Harekrishna Pally, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling under custody along with following seized articles:

- (i) One battery styled as "Eastman", blue in colour displaying No. 265RG3KCE11S16733 seized from the possession of accused Nikhil Roy.
- (ii) One red colour Exide battery displaying No. A2H3G044771 2H34, OCV 12.53V, Battery type: FEY5-EY700L seized from the possession of accused Rohit Thakur.

I, ASI Munna Ahmed of Bagdogra PS, SPC, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted arrested two accused persons to the effect that today on 15.11.2024 at 12:05 hrs I received reliable source information that some stolen articles (battery) are kept concealed at Station More under Bagdogra PS. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and diarized the matter in GD vide GDE No. 831 dated 15.11.2024 and formed a raiding team consisting ASI Amit Lama, CV/389 Janak Singh & CV/375 Jogesh Barman led by me and left for Station More to work out the source information. This refers to MCC No. 303/24 dated 15.11.24. At around 12:15 hrs we reached near Station More under Bagdogra PS and after a while source indicated one suspect there. Accordingly, we apprehended the suspect and interrogated him. On interrogation, he disclosed his identity as Rohit Thakur (M/20), s/o- Somnath Thakur, resident of Harekrishna Pally, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and revealed that before Chhat puja he had stolen away two batteries from Bagdogra Bihar more side and he has already sold one of the batteries to a nearby battery shop at Station more. He agreed to help Police to locate the shop where he had sold the battery. Accordingly, we left for the battery shop. He identified the battery shop styled as "Grip Battery" at station more under Bagdogra PS. We detained the shop owner there and interrogated him. On interrogation, he identified himself as the owner of that shop and disclosed his identity as Nikhil Roy (M/57), s/o- Late Bhusan Ch. Roy, resident of Khudiram Pally, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling. He further confessed his guilt and admitted that a few days ago said Rohit Thakur had come to his shop with a battery in his possession and he had dishonestly purchased the article (battery) without any valid document @ Rs. 2500/-. He has shown and identified the battery. There is reasonable suspicion that the shop owner Nikhil Roy has dishonestly received & purchased the stolen article without any valid document for his wrongful gain and assisted the thief to conceal the stolen property. Accordingly, I recovered the battery which is supposed to be a stolen property and seized the same under proper seizure list. At last, I arrested said Nikhil Roy after telling him the ground of arrest to prevent the accused person from committing any further offence, to prevent him to cause disappearance of evidence as well as for proper investigation of the case and issued memo of arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest is done in between 12:46 hrs & 13:00 hrs on 15.11.2024. Then, we further interrogated the accused Rohit Thakur. On prolong interrogation; he further confessed that he has kept concealed another stolen article (battery) in a lonely place at Khudiram Pally under Bagdogra PS. Subsequently, we had been to Khudiram Pally. After a lapse of time in the evening the involved accused Rohit Roy located the place where he had concealed the stolen article (battery). Subsequently, on being shown & identified by the accused, we recovered the stolen article and seized the same under proper seizure list. At last, I arrested said Rohit Takur after telling him the ground of arrest to prevent the accused person from committing any further offence, to prevent him to cause disappearance of evidence as well as for proper investigation of the case and issued memo of

arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest is done in between 18:38 hrs & 18:50 hrs on 15.11.2024. The entire process of search, seizure & arrest is done through audio-video electronic means using mobile phone and then the same audio-video record is converted to a pen drive using computer system.

Under the above fact & circumstances, I request you to initiate a specific case under proper sections of law against the above mentioned two involved arrested accused persons and arrange for its investigation.
