Sub: HANDING OVER OF RAKESH MISTREE, S/O LATE PANCHU MISTREE RESIDENCE OF KHOLA CHAND FAFRI WHO WAS CAUGHT BY THE BSF PATROLLING PARTY ON STEALING THE ELECTRICAL WIRES AND TAPES IN BSF CAMPUS SALUGARA

On dated 19.11.2024 a patrolling party consisting of HC(GD) Pawan Kumar and HC(GD) Javed Ahmed saw a person trespassing boundary wall of STC BSF Campus Salugara and going out of campus in Baikunthpur forest behind 'F' Coy Barrack area. After this, when the patrolling party went behind him they found a person named Rakesh Mistree, Age appx -28 years, S/o Late Panchu Mistree, residence of Khola Chand Fafri. On inquiring about his purpose, he didn't answer. On searching, he was found in possession of electrical wires and water tapes which he acknowledge that he stole from newly constructed bath room block in 'F' Coy barrack. When the bathroom block was searched, a window was found broken and all the electrical wiring alongwith tapes was missing from it.

- The person revealed that in past he himself executed all such theft in STC BSF Campus Salugara and sold the stolen items in scraps shop, Siliguri.
- He is being handed over to Police alongwith his present medical examination certificate i.e. fit and in all senses and seized items from his possession.
