Subject: Complaint regarding the theft of computer parts from Medica Cancer Hospital, Rangapani by one Mr. Subhankar Chakraborty of IT Department.

Dear Sir,

We would like to inform you that Mr. Subhankar Chakraborty, residing at Maddhya Santi Nagar, Dabgram(P), Near Aamtala Club P.O Dabgram, 734004 and contactable at 8372802303, an employee of the IT department deputed at our Medica Cancer Hospital (MCH), Rangapani, West Bengal, has admitted to taking major hardware components from the computers of MCH.

This has caused significant disruptions to the hospital's operations. The issue was identified on 13th September 2024 when the computer systems stopped functioning. Our IT head from Medica North Bengal Clinic attended to the unit at Rangapani.

Upon inquiring about the missing hardware, Mr. Chakraborty admitted to removing the parts and claimed that he could no longer locate them. He confirmed the missing hardware in an email and requested additional time from the hospital management, assuring that he would return the parts.

He has not attended the office since the issue surfaced. We have tried reaching out to him to visit the hospital, and we have spoken to him over the phone, where he has agreed to send a formal email confirming that he was responsible for removing the RAM from the newly installed computers. We are enclosing copies of this email as Annexure-1, in which he acknowledges the removal of the parts.

Despite multiple follow-ups, during which he promised to visit the hospital and reinstall the missing parts, he has failed to fulfil his commitments to date.

As a result, the hospital is facing serious challenges in managing its patient databases and software systems.

Despite giving him ample time, he has failed to return the items as promised. We did not report this matter earlier to the local police station because he had reassured us that he would visit the hospital and rectify his wrongdoing.
