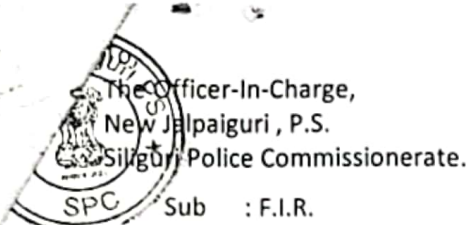

In producing herewith two (02) arrested accused persons namely (1) Indresh Kumar s/o Singheswar Ray of vill. Dagru, PO. Chhiritur, PS. Mahua, Dist. Baishali, Bihar (Driver) (2) Praveen Kumar (22) s/o Jagannath Thakur of vill. Vashi, PO. Kadilpur, PS. Jandahar, Dist. Baishali, Bihar (co-driver) along with following seizure list:-

1. 40 (fourty) nos. of Buffalos including 22 (twenty two) nos of Calves in Black colour and different size.
2. One truck having registration number AS-01LC/2683 which was used to carry the seized Buffalos SL.No. 1.
3. One Driving License having no. WB0120190013759 in the name of Indresh Kumar s/o Singheswar Ray, date of issue. 29.09.19 valid upto 20.02.27.

I, SI Chabilal Sinha of NJP P.S. Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this complaint against the above noted arrested accused persons to the effect that on 08.12.24 at about 15.25 hrs in course of QRT-II mobile duty alongwith NVF/0071 Pradyut Roy and VP/08 Laxman Roy received a source information that some vehicles are being loaded Buffalos illegally and coming from Bihar side towards Jalpaiguri side through Fulbari bypass. Accordingly I informed about the information to you and duty officer of PS and as per direction myself alongwith force left for Fulbari Toll plaza to verify the veracity of the information vide NJP PS GDE No.446 dt. 08.12.24.

On reaching at Fulbari Toll Plaza at 15-55 hrs and started Naka checking of the upcoming vehicles and on identified by the source I intercepted one vehicle bearing No.AS-01-LC/2683 and apprehended the driver and co-driver of the said vehicle. On asked they disclosed their name and address mentioned above. On checking the vehicle we found that total 40 number of Buffalos includeing 22 (Twenty two) numbers of calves loaded in that vehicle. On further interrogation both the driver stated that they were carrying the Buffalos from-Bihar to Assam side. On demand they failed to produce any valid documents/license for being possession of the cattle nor any live stock permit of the above noted Buffalos loaded in the said vehicle. Even they could not produce any valid papers in r/o of the vehicle in which the buffalos were loaded. It was also found that the Buffalos and calf were kept in such manner of position causing to unnecessary pain and suffering to the cattle's and not maintaining Govt. rules to carry the same. It was reasonably believed that the above noted drivers of the vehicle obtained the cattle's either by stolen or fraudulent means as there was no any documents in support of the same nor could they indicate the source of its procurement.

Hence, I arrested the above noted accused driver and co-driver and seized the buffalos alongwith offending vehicle no.AS-01-LC/2683 and driving license of the driver under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. Whole process of search and seizure made between 16.45 hrs to 17.35 hrs. After completion of seizure, I deposited all the seized 18 (Eighteen) numbers of big size Buffalo black color and 22 (Twenty tow) numbers of Buffalo calf to the Khoar situated at Amaidighi, Fulbari and the seized vehicle kept at PS compound. The accused drivers are violated the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act.

Under the above fact & circumstances I therefore request you to start a case under proper section of law against the above noted two accused drivers namely (1) Indresh Kumar(23) s/o Singheswar Ray of vill. Dagru, PO. Chhiritur, PS. Mahua, Dist. Baishali, Bihar (Driver) (2) Praveen Kumar (22) s/o Jagannath Thakur of vill. Vashi, PO. Kadilpur, PS. Jandahar, Dist. Baishali, Bihar and arrange for the investigation.
