Subject: FIR regarding an attempt to murder

Respected Sir,

I, the undersigned, would like to lodge a written complaint regarding an attempt to murder against one Samir Singha, son of Sabulal Singha, residing at Bairagini Jote, P.S. Bagdogra District Darjeeling.

On 3rd January 2025, at around 7:30 PM, the accused namely, Samir Singha, called my son namely Satyajit Singh, residing at Bairagini Jote, under the jurisdiction of P.S. Bagdogra, District Darjeeling on the phone, inviting him for first rice ceremony. Acting as part of a pre-planned conspiracy, the accused brutally attacked him with a sharp cutting weapon, inflicting four severe injuries on his body with the clear intention to kill him.

Due to the grievous nature of the injuries, he is currently admitted to North Bengal Medical College and Hospital and is undergoing critical medical treatment.

This deliberate and violent act constitutes an attempt to murder. I kindly request you to register this complaint and take immediate and appropriate legal action against the accused.
