Sir,

I am producing herewith 01 (one) accused person namely Bittu Das (24) s/o- Mantu Das of Purba Hatiadanga, PO- Goghomali, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure viz (i) 01 small improvised firearm (one shutter) measuring 8 inches in length including its butt having firing pin, firing hammer, trigger in a working condition marked as (Exhibit "A") (ii) 01 (one) round live ammunition (8MM) measuring approximately 7 cm marked as (Exhibit "A1").

I, SI Agen Lepcha s/o Lt. Dup Tshering lepcha of Ashighar Out Post under Bhaktinagar PS, SPC do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above-noted accused person. On 16/01/2025 at 13:05 hrs, I received specific confidential information that an individual was waiting near Jeremel's Academy School with illegal firearms, intending to sell them to a designated customer.

Accordingly, I diarized the information in the General diary vide Ashighar Out Post GDE No 457 dated 16/01/2025 and informed the fact to OC/ Ashighar Out Post. Accordingly as per his kind order and direction I along with ASI Dinesh Chandra Roy and force left for Telipara near Jeremel's Academy School with an investigation kit to work out the information by Govt, vehicle vide Ashighar Out Post GDE No 458 dated 16/01/2025 and M.C.C. No. 76/25 dated 16/01/25. Under this circumstance, any search warrant or authorization for search could not be obtained for want of time. So we had to move fast without affording the miscreant, the opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for his escape.

On our way to Jeremel's Academy School, I contacted two independent witnesses namely Tapas Roy (33) s/o Lt. Ramesh Roy of Majhabari, PO Goghomali, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, and Rana Bose (44) s/o Lt. Ujjwal Bose of Ashighar Coony near the Anchal Office, PO Goghomali, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri. We identified ourselves as a police officer of Ashighar Out Post and requested their presence as witnesses during the search and seizure, to which they agreed.

Then, I contacted my source and as indicated by the source we noticed a person standing on a vacant plot near Jeremel's Academy. We cordoned the place from every corner with due care and caution. On seeing police personnel approaching him, he tried to flee away from the spot but on hot chase, we were able to apprehend him. We then identified ourselves as police personnel from Ashighar Out Post to the apprehended person. (We were in civilian dress for convenience). Upon interrogation, the individual disclosed his identity as noted above. Following that on search 01 small improvised firearm (one shutter) measuring 8 inches in length including its butt having firing pin, firing hammer, and trigger in working condition and (ii) 01 (one) round live ammunition (8MM) measuring approximately 7 cm in length was recovered from his exclusive and conscious possession. On demand individual was unable to provide any documentation regarding the firearm and ammunition found in his possession, indicating his illegal possession of these items.

Subsequently, I seized the aforementioned articles from him in the presence of independent witnesses, documented in the proper seizure list, which was duly signed by the witnesses and acknowledged by the accused. The search, seizure, and labelling occurred between 13:55 hrs and 14:10 hrs, with videography, and he was subsequently arrested according to a memo of arrest, which informed him of the grounds for his arrest.

Given the above facts and the seizure of incriminating articles, there is strong reason to believe that the accused person, Bittu Das (24), son of Mantu Das of Purba Hatiadanga, PO - Goghomali, PS - Bhakti Nagar, Dist. - Jalpaiguri, is desperate and dangerous. He was carrying the firearm and live ammunition either for sale or to commit a heinous crime in the locality.

As he willfully violated the regulation of the Arms Act, I, therefore pray before your good self that a specific case may kindly be initiated against the accused person namely Bittu Das (24) s/o- Mantu Das of Purba Hatiadanga, PO- Goghomali, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under proper section of the law and may arrange to cause its investigation.
