Sir,

I'm producing herewith 01 (one) accused person namely Mukesh Biswakarma (27 yrs) S/O Rajen Biswakarma of Nandok, PS. Ranipool, Gangtok, Dist.-East Sikkim under arrest and the following articles under seizure viz (i) 01 iron made improvised small fire arms approx length 29 cm including iron made pistol grip, having barrel, trigger, firing pin and hammer in proper working condition, (Exhibit "A") (ii) 01 (one) live ammunition (Exhibit "B").

I, SI, Rajiv Subba of Pradhan Nagar PS, SPC do hereby lodged this written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Mukesh Biswakarma (27 yrs) S/O Rajen Biswakarma of Nandok, PS. Ranipool, Gangtok, Dist.-East Sikkim to the effect that today i.e. on 15.02.25 at 22.15 hrs I received a specific secret source information that one person is moving at Gate Bazar near Bani Mandir High School area with illegal fire arms with a view to sell the same to his designed customer or to commit heinous crime. Accordingly, I diarized the information in PS General diary vide Pradhan Nagar PS GDE No. 884 dated 15.02.25 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind order and direction myself along with ASI Biplab Kr Das, ASI Sajal Das, ASI Prabal Sarkar and force left for Gate Bazar near Bani Mandir High School under P.S- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling with investigation kit to work out the information by Govt, vehicle vide Pradhan Nagar M.C.C. No. 307/25 dated 15.02.25. Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization for search cannot be obtained for want of time. So we had to move fast without affording the miscreant, the opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for his escape. After arrival at Gate Bazar near Bani Mandir School, I approached to two persons for independent witnesses nemly (i) Bijan Adhikary S/O Biren Adhikary of PaTI Colony, Road, No-03, Ward No-47, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling and (ii) Kartick Sah S/O Late Chandrika Sah of BRI Colony, Ward No-01, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling and requested them to remain present and act as witness during search and seizure if required upon which they agreed. Then, I contacted with my source and as indicated by the source we noticed that one person was standing near Bani Mandir High School, Diesel Colony under PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling. We cordoned the place from every corner with due care and caution. On seeing police personnel approaching towards him, he tried to flee away from the spot but on hot chase we could be able to apprehend him. Thereafter, we disclosed our identities as Police personnel (as we were in civil dress for our convenience). On interrogation, he disclosed his identity as noted above. On search recovered 01 iron made improvised small fire arms approx length 29 cm including iron made pistolgrip, having barrel, trigger, firing pin and hammer in proper working condition, (ii) 01 (one) live ammunition from his exclusive and conscious possession. On demand he failed to produce any document in respect of fire Arm and ammunition which was found in his exclusive and conscious possession. On interrogation he admitted that he came to delever the same to his design customer for his wrongful gain. Thus, when his involvement in carrying and possessing illegal Fire arm and ammunition was established, further I seized the above mentioned articles from his possession in presence of independent witnesses noted above under proper seizure list and duly signed by the witness and acknowledge by the accused person. The search seizure and label were made in between 22.40 hrs to 23.30 hrs under coverage of videography as per norms of BNSS and subsequently arrested him by preparing memo of arrest informing him about the ground of his arrest in written.

Under the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles, there is strong reason to believe that the said accused person namely Mukesh Biswakarma (27 yrs) S/O Rajen Biswakarma of Nandok, PS. Ranipool, Gangtok, Dist., East Sikkim is desperate and dangerous in nature, as he was carrying the said Fire arm and live ammunition with an objective to sell the same or to commit heinous crime in the locality.

As he wilfully violated the regulation of Arms Act, I, therefore pray before your good self that a specific case may kindly be initiated against the accused person namely Mukesh Biswakarma (27 yrs) S/O Rajen Biswakarma of Nandok, PS. Ranipool, Gangtok, Dist.- East Sikkim under proper section of law and may arrange to cause its investigation.
