In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Ranjit Das (M/52), S/O-Haribandhu Das Sir, of Gossainpur, PS-Bagdogra, Dist.- Darjeeling along with following seized article:

Three (03) sets of new pattern Indian Army combat uniform each measuring 40 meter Le Total-120 (i)

1 ASI Everentius Dempta of Bagdogra Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 08/03/25 while I along with HG/1118-Dipesh Singha, CV/384-Santosh Roy were performing morning Van duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No- Dated-08/03/25 at about 13.15 hrs I received a secret source of information that one person is storing and selling Indian Army uniform illegally without any papers/documents from his shop styled as "Ranjit Tailors" located at Bagdogra Bihar More. Accordingly, Unformed the fact to on duty GDE officer as well as O/C Bagdogra PS and as per his kind direction I along with force left for Bagdogra Bihar More to verify the information in hand. At about 13.30 hrs we reached at Bagdogra Bihar More and as per indication of source, we held raid at a shop styled as "Ranjit Tailors' and detain the owner of the said shop. On being asked the owner of the shop disclosed his name and identity as Ranjit Das (M/52), S/O-Haribandhu Das of Gossainpur, PS-Bagdogra, Dist.- Darjeeling .On search 1 found and recovered Three (03) sets of new pattern Indian Army combat uniform each measuring 40 meter i.e Total-120 meter which is prohibited to sale outside by common public except army personnel and the fabrication and supply will only be made available to the troops of Indian Army through central procurement and canteen stores department. The authorized fabric or uniform will not be made available for open sale in civil market. The Indian Amy has obtained the requisite Intellectual Property Right (IPR) for the Design and Camouflaged from the office of Controller General of Patents, Design & Trademark. Thus, the owner of the shop clearly violated the order. On asked the owner of the shop could not produce any valid papers or documents for storing the said material. On further interrogation the owner of the shop accepted that since long he has been storing and selling the said army uniform from his shop "Ranjit Tailors" illegally without any valid documents or papers for his illegal gain. He also confessed that he is well aware of the govt. order which prohibits general public to sell Army uniform except any army personnel. Accordingly, I seized the above noted article as per proper seizure list in presence of witnesses from the possession said Ranjit Das (M/52), S/O-Haribandhu Das of Gossainpur, PS-Bagdogra, Dist. Darjeeling and arrested him after issuing proper memo of arrest and the communication of ground of arrest has duly been communicated to him in presence of witnesses. As per provision the entire process of search and seizure was done by audio/video electronic means which has been converted into a Pen drive. The search, seizure and arrest were made in between 13.43 hrs to 13.50 hrs on 08/03/25.

Therefore I pray before you to start a specific case against said Ranjit Das (M/52), S/O-Haribandhu Das of Gossainpur, PS-Bagdogra, Dist.- Darjeeling under proper section of Law and arrange for its investigation.
