With due regards, I, **SMT. RANJITA PAUL (GOSWAMI)**,
Wife of Sri Bhanu Paul, Daughter of Late Balai Goswami, Presently
residing at Swamiji More, Haider Para, Siliguri, P.O. Haider Para, P.S.
Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, would like to lodge this
written complaint to the effect that my marriage was solemnized on
07.02.2001 with Sri Bhanu Paul, Son of Sri Narayan Ch. Paul of
Jhankar More, Siliguri, P.O. & P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling according
to the Hindu Rites and Customs after observing all formalities of a
Hindu marriage. It is to be mentioned here that my father was expired
since last 25 years ago leaving behind my mentally ill mother, myself
and one younger sister and one brother and at the time of my
marriage, my mother with the help of the other relatives, have given so
many valuable articles like golden ornaments, furniture & fixtures,
utensils and other household articles, including cash a sum of Rs.
20,000/- only as per the demand of my husband and other in laws
members. After my marriage, I, along with my husband have started
to live and co-habited together as husband and wife at my
matrimonial house as mentioned aforesaid along with my father-in-
law Sri Narayan Ch. Paul, my mother-in-law Smt. Laxmi Paul,
Brother-in-law Sri Kanai Paul @ Kanu and his wife Smt. Tapashi Paul
and out of our lawful wedlock, three female child were born and their
name are Miss Shipra Paul, (Aged about 18 years), Miss Sushmita
Paul, (Aged about 16 years) and Miss Sweeta Paul, (Aged about 12
years). After my marriage, I have passed my marital life in my
matrimonial house happily only for a period of few months. Just after
elapse of 6/7 months, my husband and in laws members in
conspiracy with each other have started to inflict torture upon me
both physically and mentally as they were not satisfied with the
articles which was given at the time of marriage. They put pressure
upon me to bring more dowry from my parental house. My husband
has carrying on a business of Fast Food Items and almost every day,
