Sir,

In producing herewith seized articles Viz (1) One White Colour Mahindra Bolero Pick-Up Van bearing Registration No. WB 73 E 5457 with key and (2) 06 (six) blue coloured Plastic barrel of 200 liters each containing with Diesel (Total approx 1200 liters) ( Loaded in vehicle no WB 73 E 5457 ) , I SI Rajiv Subba of DD SPC, Siliguri submitting complaint against the driver and the owner of the seized vehicle no. WB 73 E 5457 to the effect that today on 12.04.2024 at 08.05 received a secret source information that the driver / owner of one White Colour Mahindra Bolero Pick-Up Van bearing Registration No. WB 73 E 5457 fraudulently or by stolen means collected huge quantity of Diesel from NJP IOC area and will proceed towards Naxalbari for Clandestine disposal for their wrongful gain. Accordingly, I diarised the information vide DD SPC, GDE No. 90 dated 12.04.2024 and inform the information to ACP, DD, SPC, Siliguri. As per order of ACP DD SPC, I along with ASI Proloy Bhattacharjee, Const.813 Gyanendra Ch Sarkar and CV-151 Montosh Talukdar all of DD SPC left DD office at 08.25 hrs vide GDE No.91 dated 12.04.2024 to verify the veracity of the source information.

At about 08.50 hrs we reached at NJP Station Road near Kashmir Colony More under NJP PS and as per the source information at about 09.15 hrs we found the alleged vehicle coming from NJP Station side and accordingly we tried to stop the vehicle. But seeing the police party the driver of vehicle no WB 73 E 5457 stopped the vehicle few distance ahead and fled from the spot leaving the vehicle. We searched the vehicle and found that the vehicle is loaded with 06 (six) blue coloured Plastic barrel of 200 liters and smell of Diesel is coming out from the said barrels. Thus it is strong reason to believe that the Driver/Owner of the said vehicle obtained the Diesel by fraudulent means or by stolen means. Accordingly , I seized the White Colour Mahindra Bolero Pick-Up Van bearing Registration No. WB 73 E 5457 with key and (2) 06 (six) blue coloured Plastic barrel of 200 liters each containing with Diesel (Total approx 1200 liters) ( Loaded in vehicle no WB 73 E 5457 ) under proper seizure list in presence and duly signed by the witnesses. The whole process of seizure was made in between 09.25 hrs and 10.05 hrs

I therefore, request you that a specific case may kindly be started against the driver / owner of Mahindra Bolero Pick-Up Van bearing Registration No. WB 73 E 5457 under section 411/414 IPC .
